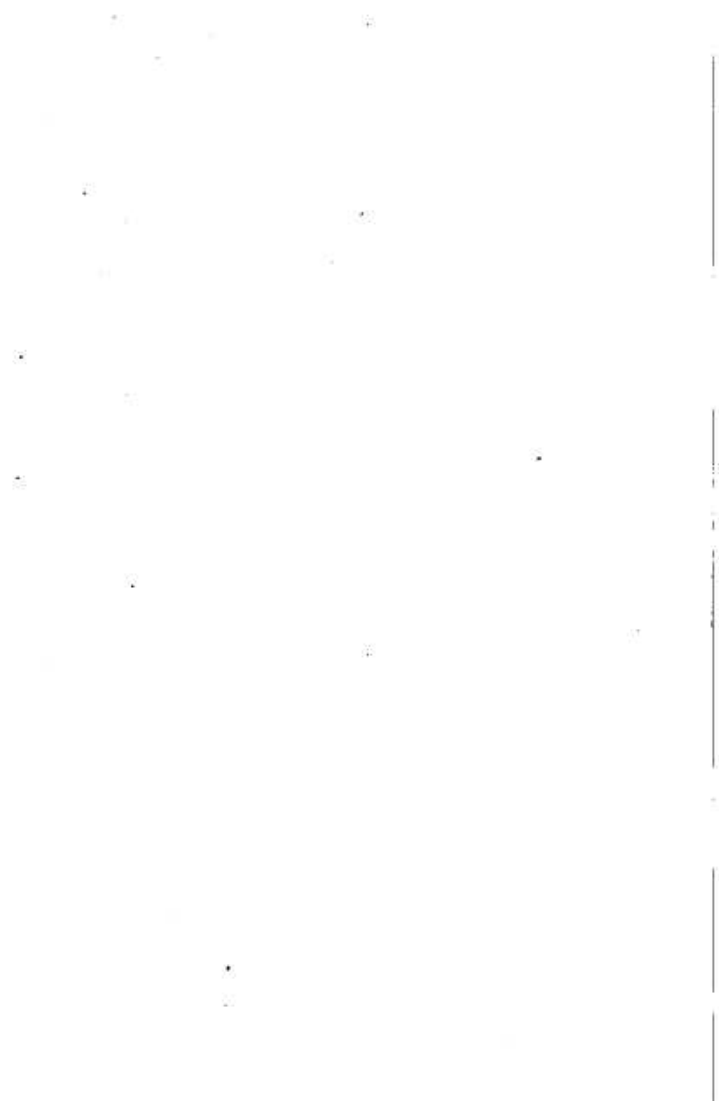

PREFACE.

A DESIRE having been expressed by many Members of the High Church Congregation and friends of the late Dr Arnot, to have some memento of their departed Pastor and friend, this work has been published to gratify that desire. Instead of a volume of sermons, it has been thought better to issue in the present form some of the prayers used by him at public worship in the High Church, together with the Communion and Baptismal Services. Those prayers and services were not written with any view to publication. It was, however, the earnest endeavour of Dr Arnot during the latter years of his ministry to make the devotional services in his Church as appropriate as possible, and accordingly he prepared with great care a series of prayers for use in the High Church, from which series those which are here printed are a selection.
