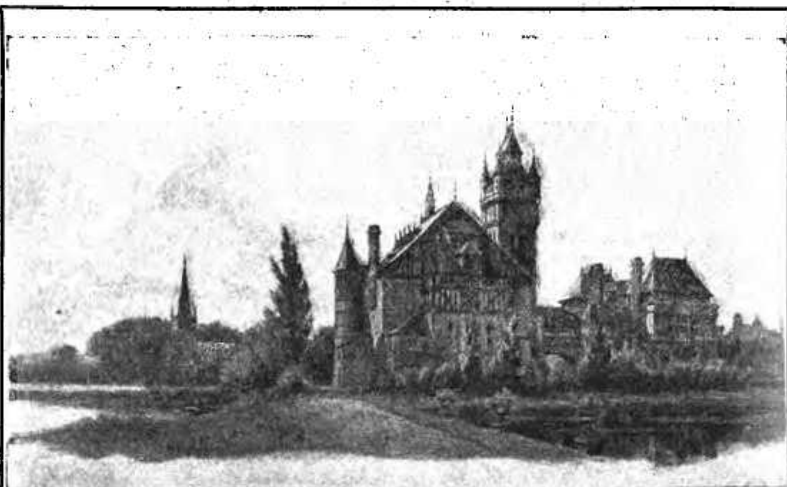

This was edited by Charles E. Flower in the last years of his life, and is adapted for actors, play-goers, and members of Shakespeare Reading Societies. It gives the stage arrangements while preserving the original text in its entirety; the sentences usually omitted being printed in smaller type, enable the reader at once to compare the acting with the full text; and the difference between the plays as written and as now acted is readily seen. The Editor aimed especially at producing an edition which could be read aloud in general society.

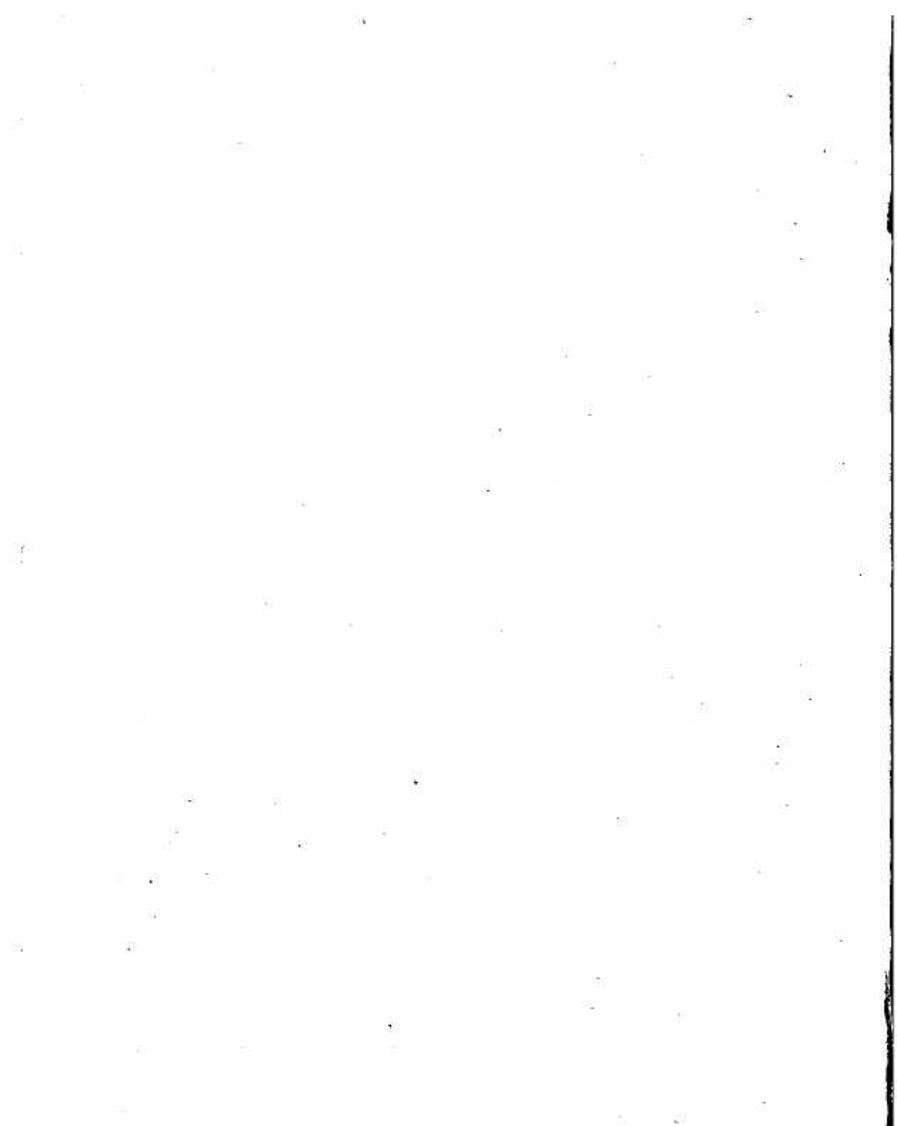
