The work of preparing them for the press has been performed by the General Editor, who has received, and desires to acknowledge, much valuable assistance. The Rev. H. E. Salter, M.A., has kindly collated many of the transcripts with their original; Prebendary Hingeston-Randolph has read most of the pages in type, and, while detecting some errors, offered very useful suggestions, which, however, could only be followed as far as the plan of the work allowed. The Rev. W. O. Massingberd, M.A., examined the identifications of all the Lincolnshire names, and supplied many modern equivalents to the old forms—an undertaking only possible to one thoroughly at home in Lincolnshire topography. To each of these authorities thanks are offered for contributing to Volume III much of the accuracy and usefulness which it is hoped it will be found to possess.

Archidiaconatus Bedfordie.

[*Ralph, chaplain, presented by the Prior and Convent of Merton, is instituted to a vicarage of five marks at St. Peter's de Merton, Bedford. A pension of two marks is annually due to the Convent, and is to be increased to five marks when the vicarage allows.*]

BEDEFORDE SANCTI PETRI.—Facta inquisitione per Magistrum S., Officialem Archidiaconi Bedfordie, super ecclesia beati Petri Bedfordie, per quam negotium fuit in expedito, Radulphus, cappellanus, ad presentationem Prioris et conventus de Meretone, admissus est ad perpetuam vicariam quinque marcarum in eadem ecclesia, et in ea canonice persona institutus, qui dictam ecclesiam tenebit nomine perpetue vicarie, reddendo inde ipsis Priori et conventui secundum statum presentem ipsius ecclesie duas marcas annuas nomine pensionis. Ita tamen quod si meliorari ceperit vicaria, crescat et ipsa pensio secundum augmentum meliorationis si fieri poterit usque ad quinque marcas, salva semper vicario integra porcione sua quinque marcarum ut predictum est. Et mandatum est dicto Officiali ut ipsum Radulphum juxta formam premissam in corporalem prefate vicarie possessionem inducat.

[*Richard, chaplain, presented by the representative of the Master of the Temple, is instituted vicar of Langford. One mark is annually due to the Templars. The vicarage is described.*]

LANGEFORDE.—Ricardus, cappellanus, presentatus per Fratrem Alanum Martell, gerentem vices Magistri Militie Templi in Anglia, ad vicariam perpetuam ecclesie de Langeforde, facta prius inquisitione per Magistrum S., Officialem Archidiaconi Bedfordie, per quam negotium fuit in expedito, ad ipsam, de assensu dicti Magistri per dominum Episcopum de novo ordinatam in eadem ecclesia, admissus est, et in ea canonice vicarius perpetuus institutus, salva fratribus Militie Templi una marca annua de predicta vicaria; que quidem vicaria consistit in altaragio prefate ecclesie et in omnibus spectantibus ad eam ecclesiam preter decimas garbarum et decimas provenientes de molendin[is], et preter terram ecclesie.

[*John de Winterborne, clerk, is instituted to the church of Chellington, in succession to Walter, preferred to Thrapstone.*]

CHELEWENTONE.—Magister Johannes de Winterborne, clericus, presentatus ad ecclesiam de Chelewentone, vacantem eo quod

Walterus, qui eam proximo possedit, suscepit post Concilium ecclesiam de Trapstone, facta prius inquisitione per Magistrum S., Officialem Archidiaconi Bedefordie, per quam, etc., admissus est et in ea canonice persona institutus. Et mandatum est dicto Officiali, etc.

[*Robert de Sivelesho, deacon, presented by the Prior and Canons of Dunstable, is instituted vicar of Pulloxhill. The vicarage is described.*]

PULLOKESHILLE.—Robertus de Sivelesho, diaconus, presentatus per Priorem et canonicos de Dunestaplia ad perpetuam vicariam ecclesie de Pullokeshelle, facta inquisitione per Magistrum S., Officialem Archidiaconi Bedefordie, per quam negotium, etc., admissus est et in ea canonice vicarius perpetuus institutus. Consistit autem dicta vicaria in toto altaragio illius ecclesie, in x acris terre, et in tertia parte decimarum garbarum totius ville, preterquam de feodo Willelmi Wiscardi et Henrici Buignum. Et mandatum est prefato Officiali, etc.

[*Stephen de Ekintone, presented by the Abbot and Convent of Ramsey, is instituted to the church of Shillington. The ancient pension is reserved to the Monks.*]

SETLINGDONE.—Magister Stephanus de Ekintone, presentatus per Abbatem et conventum de Rameseia ad ecclesiam de Sutlingdone, facta prius inquisitione per J., Archidiaconum Bedefordie, per quam, etc., admissus est et in ea canonice persona institutus, cum prius esset vicarius, salva dictis monachis debita et antiqua pensione de eadem. Et mandatum est dicto Archidiacono, etc.

[*Henry, chaplain, presented by the Prior and Convent of Dunstable, is instituted vicar of Studham. The vicarage is described. A pension of one mark is reserved to the Convent.*]

STODHAM VICARIA.—Henricus, cappellanus, presentatus per Priorem et conventum de Dunstaplia ad perpetuam vicariam ecclesie de Stodhame, ordinatam auctoritate Concilii, facta prius inquisitione per J., Archidiaconum Bedefordie, per quam, etc., admissus est et in ea canonice vicarius perpetuus institutus. Et consistit dicta vicaria in toto altaragio ejusdem ecclesie cum manso competente et continente circiter septem acras, salvis ipsis Priori et canonicis de prefato altaragio, una marca annua et agnis. Idem autem vicarius solvet sinodalia et canonici hospitium Archidiaconi procurabunt. Et injunctum est Archidiacono presenti, etc.

[*John, chaplain, preſented by the ſame, is inſtituted vicar of Totternhoe. The vicarage is deſcribed.*]

THOTERNHO VICARIA.—Johannes, cappellanus, preſentatus per eosdem ad perpetuam vicariam eccleſie de Thoternho, ordinatam auctoritate Concilii, facta prius inquisitione per Archidiaconum Bedefordie, admiſſus eſt cum onere et pena vicariorum, et vicarius perpetuus inſtitutus. Conſiſtit autem dicta vicaria in toto altaragio ejuſdem eccleſie, et in redditu decem denariorum de terra Ricardi Godwer, et in medietate decime feni de tota parrochia. Vicarius autem ſolvat ſinodalia, et canonici procurabunt hoſpitiſm Archidiaconi. Et inſunctum eſt Archidiacono, etc.

[*Richard, chaplain, preſented by the ſame, is inſtituted vicar of Chalgrave. The vicarage is deſcribed.*]

CHAUGRAVA.—Ricardus, cappellanus, preſentatus per eosdem ad perpetuam vicariam eccleſie de Chaugrava, ordinatam auctoritate Concilii, facta prius inquisitione per dictum Archidiaconum, admiſſus eſt cum onere et pena vicariorum. Conſiſtit autem ipſa vicaria in toto altaragio, et in duabus croftis et gardino que ſunt juxta eccleſiam, quarum major que eſt ex parte occidentali continet in ſe quatuor acras, et minor crofta cum gardino assignabitur ei pro manſo, ſcilicet que eſt ex parte australi. Vicarius autem ſolvat ſinodalia, et canonici procurabunt hoſpitiſm Archidiaconi. Et inſunctum eſt Archidiacono, etc.

[*Geoffrey, chaplain, preſented by the ſame, is inſtituted vicar of Huſborne Crawley. The vicarage is deſcribed.*]

HUSSEBURNE VICARIA.—Galfridus, cappellanus, preſentatus per eosdem ad perpetuam vicariam eccleſie de Huſſeburne, ordinatam auctoritate Concilii, facta prius inquisitione per eundem, admiſſus eſt cum onere et pena vicariorum. Conſiſtit autem dicta vicaria in toto altaragio cum crofta et prato ex parte australi. Vicarius autem ſolvat ſinodalia, et canonici procurabunt hoſpitiſm Archidiaconi. Et inſunctum eſt Archidiacono, etc.

[*Robert, clerk, preſented by the ſame, is inſtituted vicar of Segenho (now a part of Ridgemont). The vicarage is deſcribed.*]

SEGENHO VICARIA.—Robertus, clericus, preſentatus per eosdem ad perpetuam vicariam eccleſie de Segenho, ordinatam auctoritate Concilii, facta prius inquisitione per eundem, admiſſus eſt cum onere et pena vicariorum. Conſiſtit autem dicta vicaria in toto altaragio, exceptis agnis qui Priori et canonicis remanebunt.
