ERRATA.

- Vol. XIII. Page 34. The sire of Butterfly (1017) is given as Colonel (71). The sire is BLACK STAR (52).
- Vol. XIV. Page 68. The 1903 foal of Princess Ena (1679) was entered as a filly instead of a colt, in error. The name is changed to PRINCE HAROLD.
- Vol. XV. Pages 17 and 18. Delete the words "white-spot," etc., from colour of the foals of Lady Emily (1434), Merry Midget (973), Rachel (844), and Susan (876).
- Vol. XV. Page 55. The entry of Lady Rachel (1736) is cancelled. This mare was entered Vol. XIV. under number (1676). Her 1904 foal is also entered Vol. XV., page 15.
- Vol. XV. Page 58. Delete from pedigree of Marjory (1745) the last two lines beginning "gr. dam Ran (532)," etc.
- Vol. XV. Page 60. Nago, foal of Noble Lady (1750), was foaled in 1902, *not* 1903.
- Vol. XVI. Page 3. Silver Bell of Coniccleugh, foal of Madge (851), was foaled in 1903, *not* 1905.
- Vol. XVI. Page 18. Stella (1692) is entered as property of Charles Douglas of Auchloch, while she belongs to Wm. Mungall of Transy.
- Vol. XVI. Page 37. MAUSER, 1901 colt foal of Marjory (1360), was sold for export to U.S.A., *not* Maia, the 1904 filly foal.
- Vol. XVI. Page 60. For Ethelreda (1218), read ETHEL-OEDA (1218).
