TEXT: And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name 1 shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall 3 not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. - MARK XVI. 17, 18.
