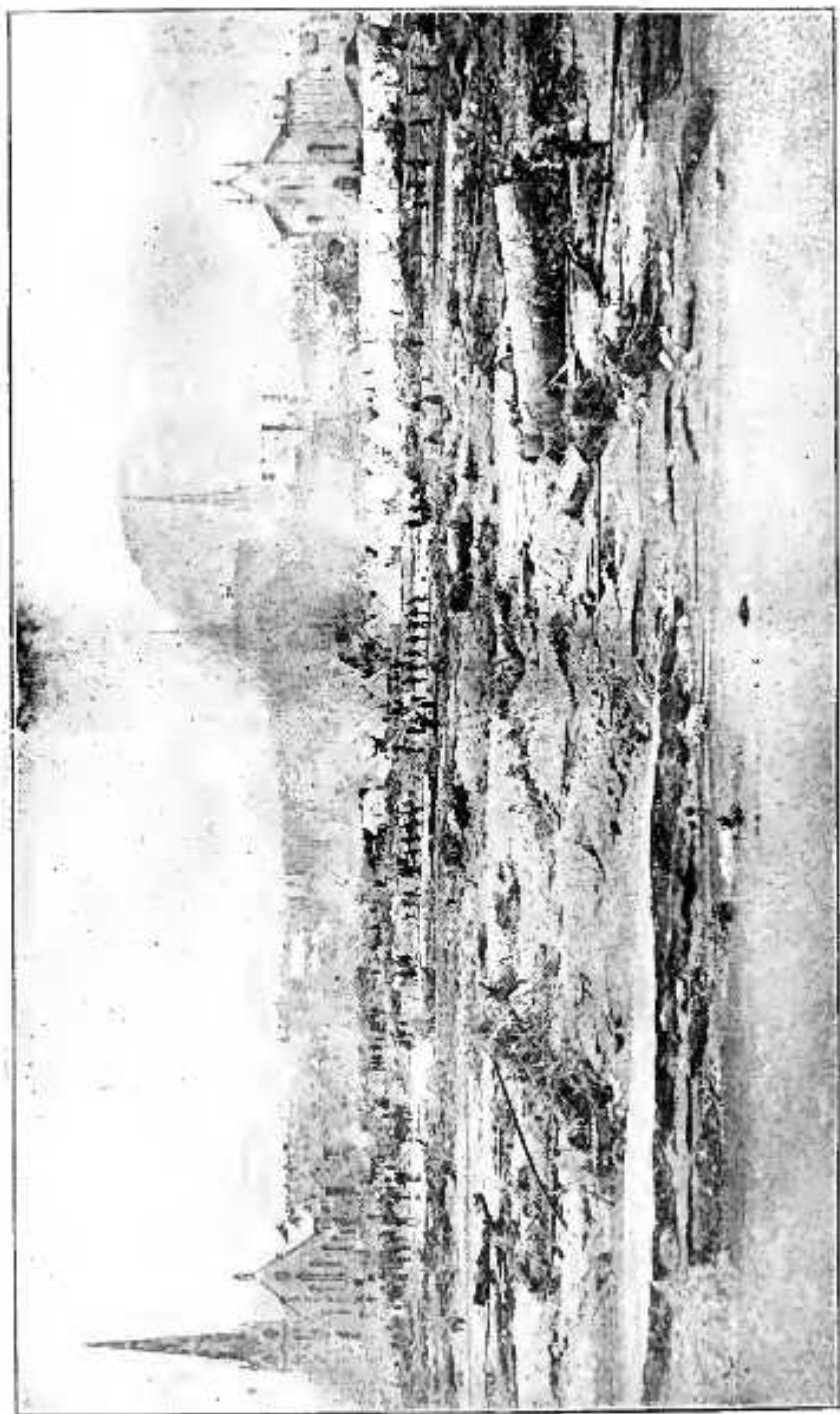

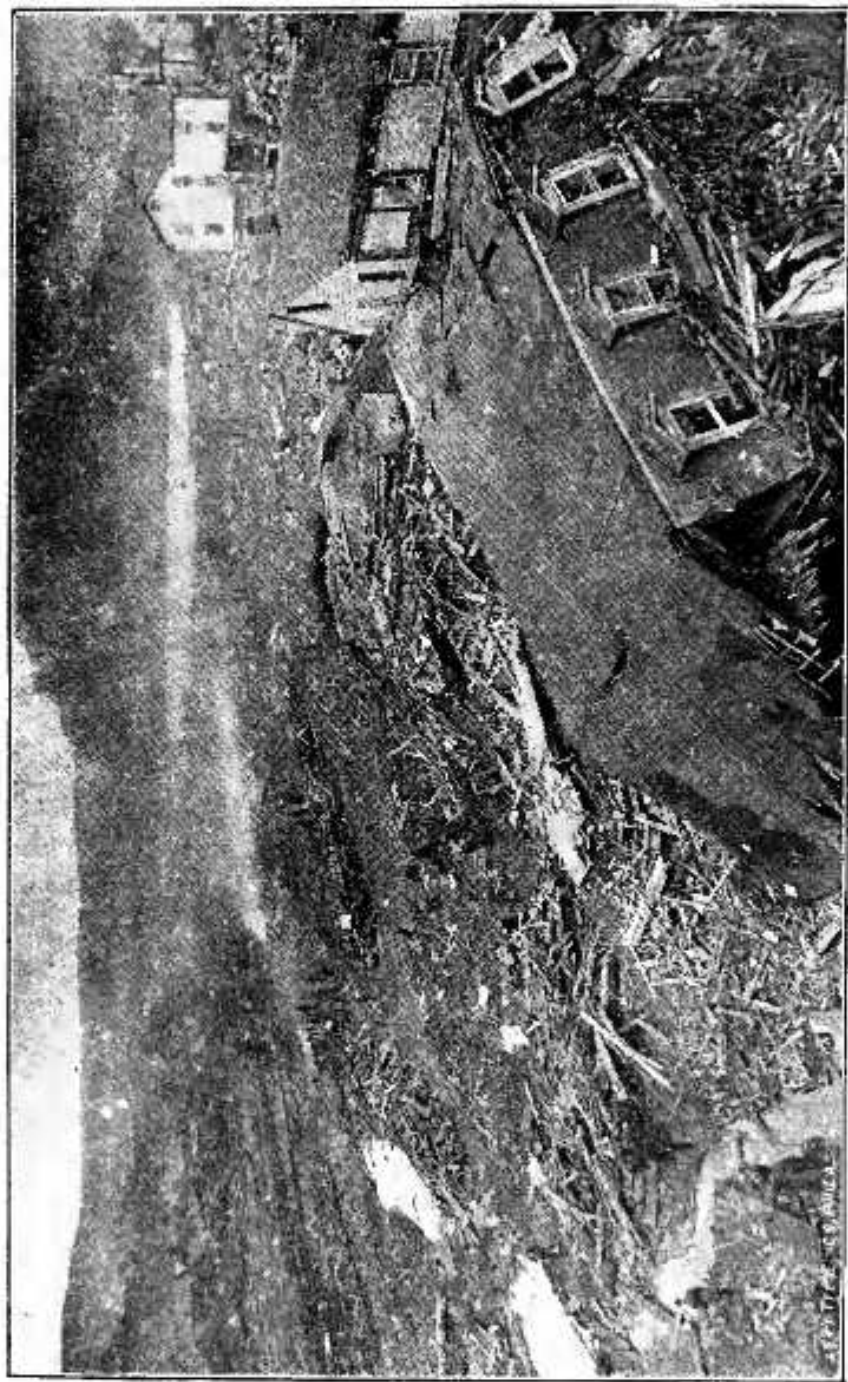

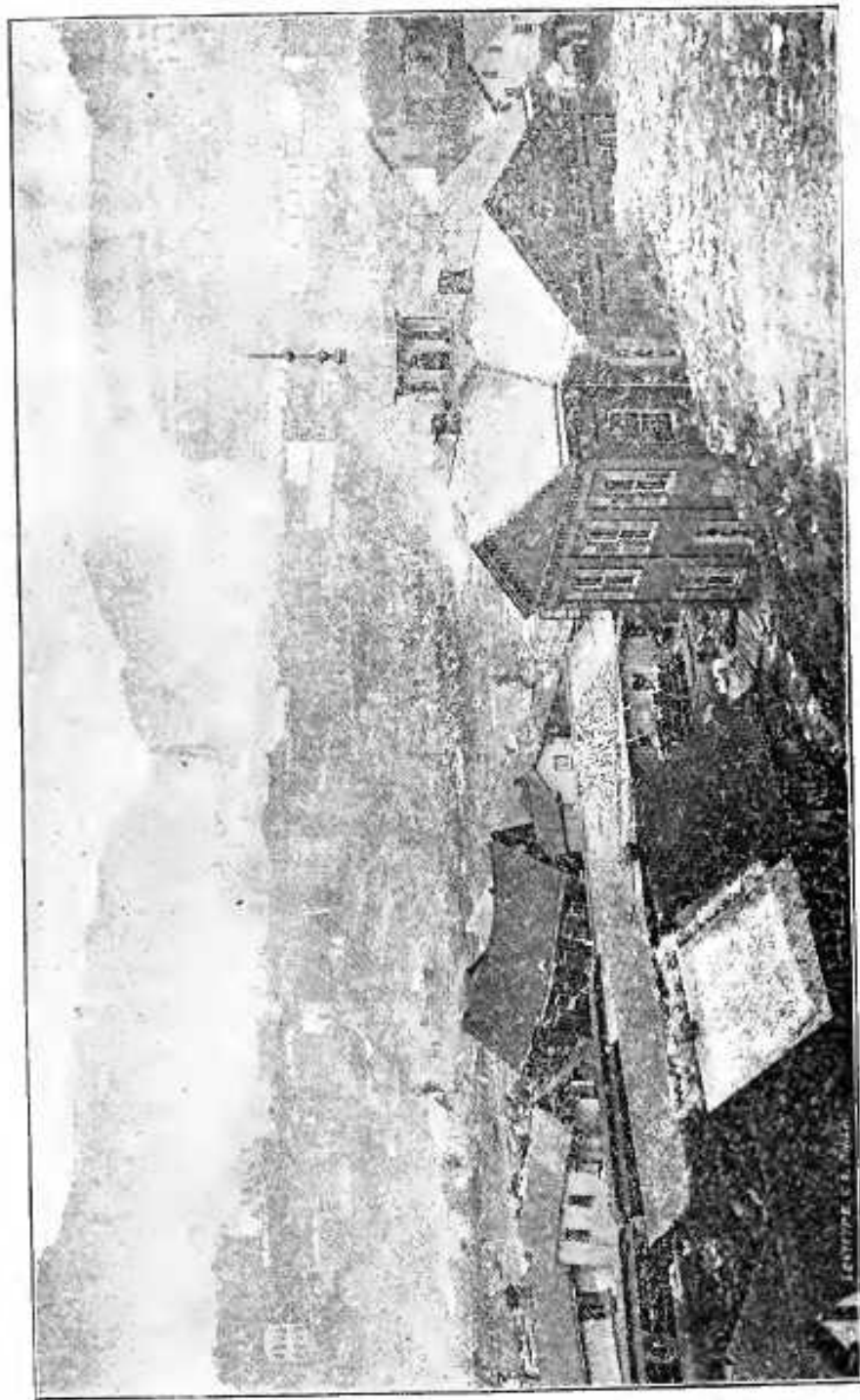

GENERAL VIEW OF JOHNSTOWN, AS LEFT BY THE FLOOD.

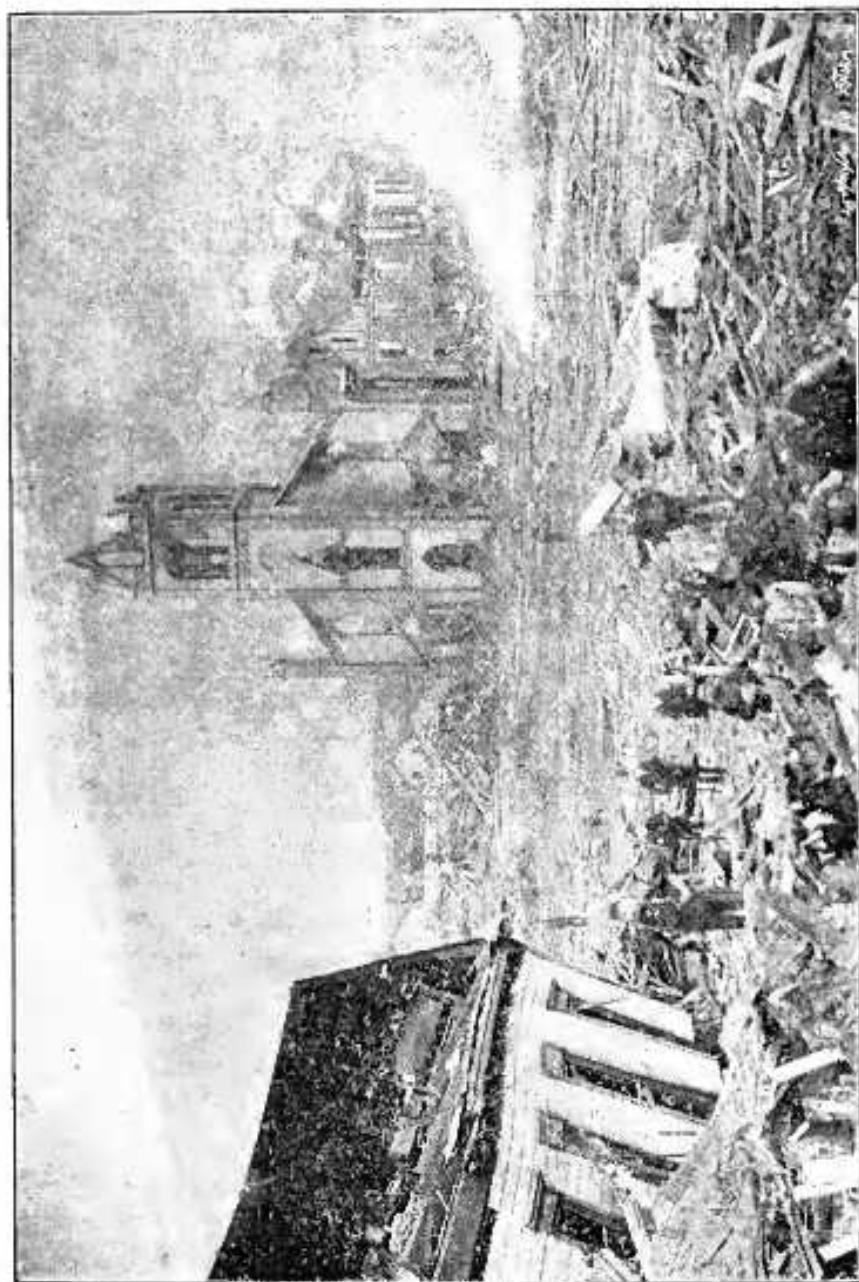


GENERAL VIEW OF JOHNSTOWN, FROM THE HILL AT THE NORTH.

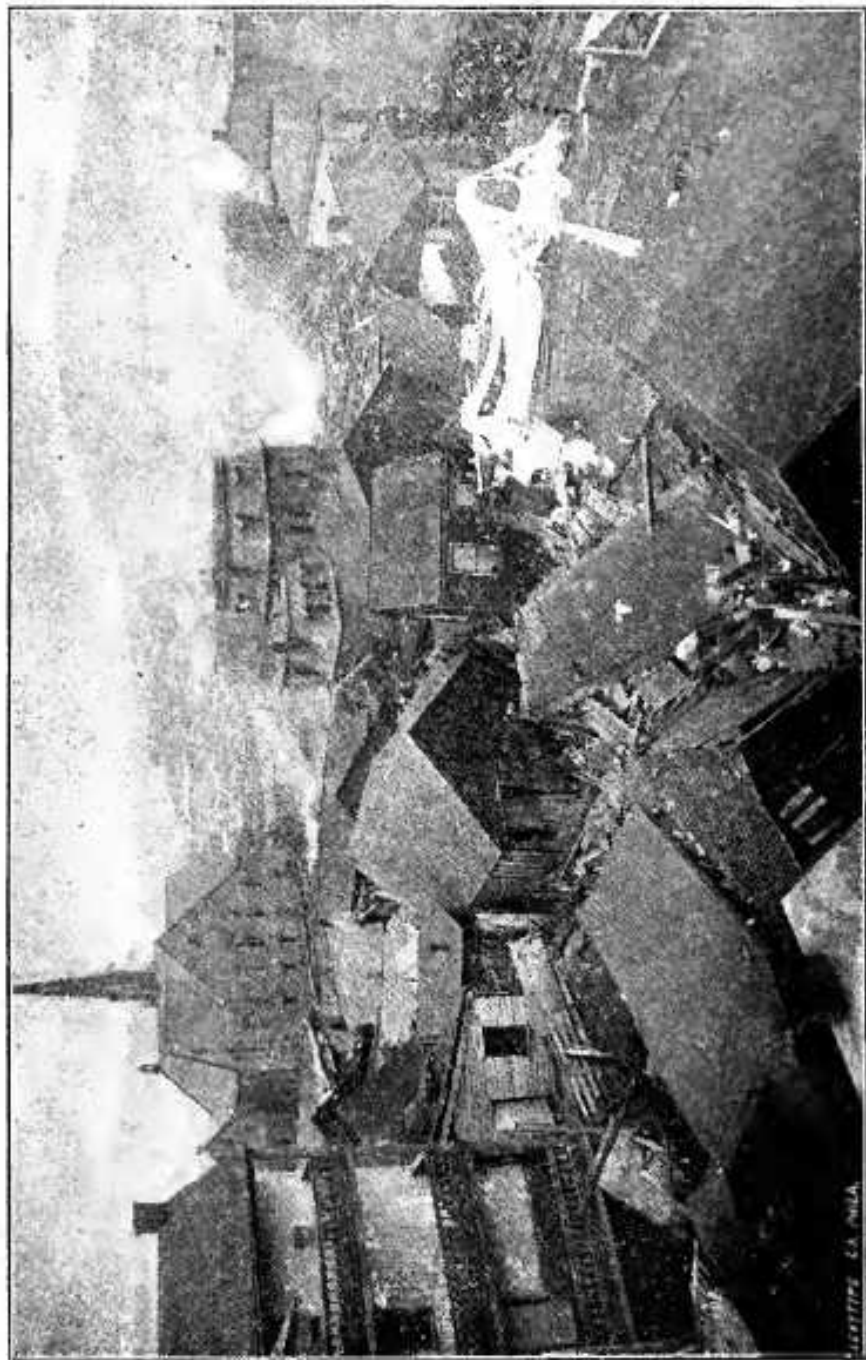


GENERAL VIEW OF JOHNSTOWN FROM THE HILL, LOOKING SOUTH.

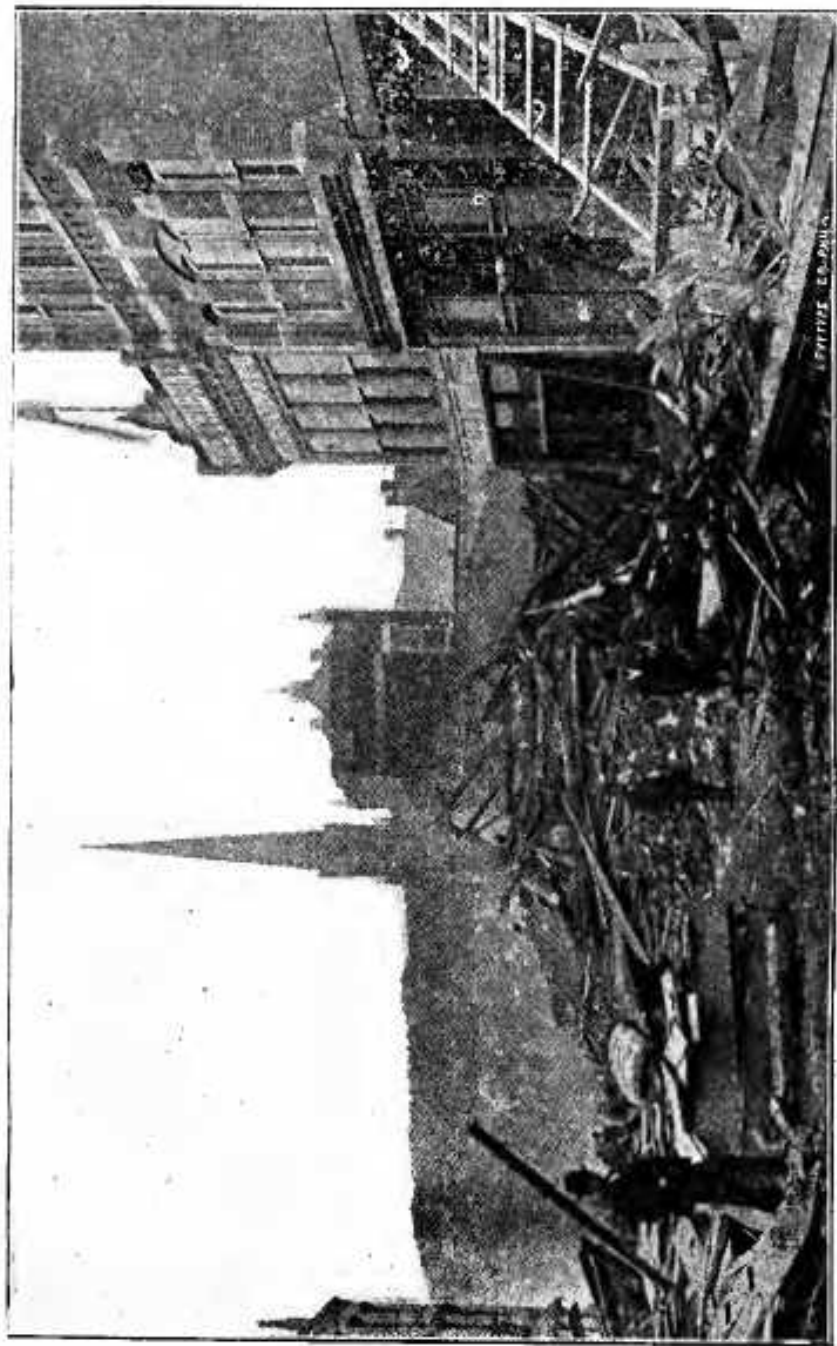
