PREFACE



CLASSMATES:—The following report I hope may serve as a strengthening link in the chain of associations which binds the Class of '72 together. The circular sent to you for its preparation contained the record printed in the last report, published four years ago, and called for such corrections as were needed. Many of the replies have contained such corrections, and nothing more. As the present report is intended, as announced in the circular, to contain only the events of our lives in the last four years, the corrections have been made in the class records, and additions only are given in the following pages, except in a few instances. This report, therefore, is naturally short, as most of us have reached a settled period, when, however strenuous our lives may be, the incidents and changes are few. Our bachelors are growing beautifully less, and I find that eighty-three per cent. of the graduated members have been married.

The Class Fund, as may be seen from the report further on, has shared in the general prosperity and has thus far

been equal to all the demands which our generous commissary, E. C. Sherburne, has made upon it.

I wish to acknowledge here my indebtedness to Wyman for his valuable assistance in publishing this report, and heartily to thank the many who have been so prompt in replying to my demands.
