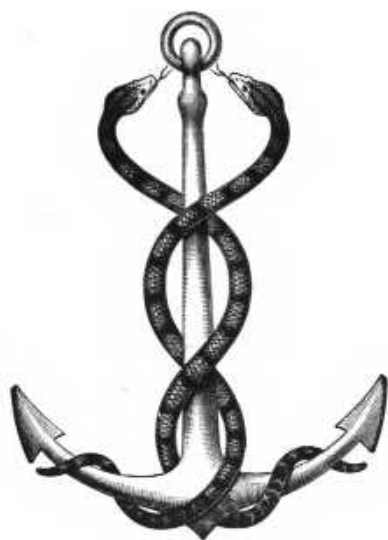

PREFACE

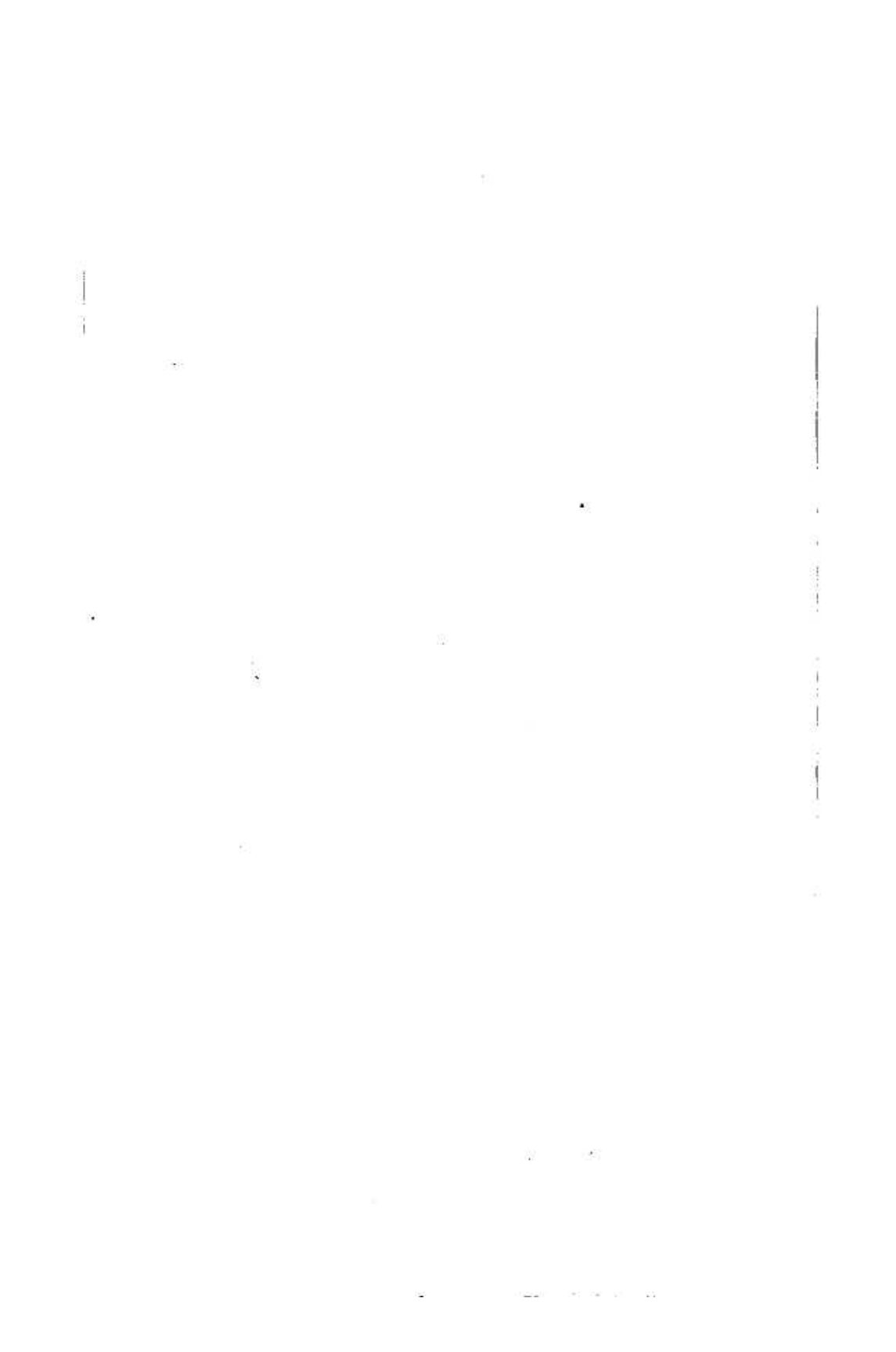
THIS book is based entirely on the experience I have gained in treating a large number of cases of Intussusception during the last thirteen years.
