The men were specially dressed in new borrowed uniforms, and were forcibly stood against the background shown. Their checks and bodies were afterwards built up by retouching the negative. This was frequently done and is a very practical explanation of the very encouraging photographs of prisoners in the German camps. No photo is allowed to go out unless it shows the prisoner in apparently good health and under pleasing conditions.
