PREFACE.

THE present forms the last of a trio of volumes of verse, namely-" Idylls o' Hame"; " Poems" (1880); and "Willie Waugh; and Other Poems." These three, I am led to believe, contain the best of my poetical effusions; while the two latter contain, also, not a few poems by my daughter, Besides these, my Temperance ELLEN C. NICHOLSON. Poems occupy two smaller volumes-"Kilwuddie," and "Tibbie's Garland "; while my Educational vols. comprise "Father Fernie, the Botanist," and "Nightly Wanderings in the Gardens of the Sky"; so that, altogether, I should say-for one denied even the common rudiments of a school education-I have written enough : quite enough to afford the world the opportunity of deciding as to their worth, and more than enough should that decision be adverse in its character.
