## PREFACE.

THE present volume presupposes an acquaintance with the rudiments of German grammar, and treats the more difficult points of syntax and usage; for example, the use of the passive voice and the conditional and subjunctive modes, the various German equivalents of the English present participle, and word-order. These points are incorporated in rules that are given in connection with the appropriate exercises, and are so arranged as to facilitate ready reference.

The appendix contains lists of adjectives and verbs that are followed by peculiar constructions, lists of words which are apt to be translated incorrectly and other lists useful for reference.
