# CONFERENCE VISITORS FOR 1889.

§ 4. Any annual conference of said Methodist Episcopal Church, which shall declare itself and become a patron of said institution, may appoint two of its members a visiting committee, who shall have power to participate in the examination of students of said institution, and inquire into the manner of conducting said institute and the teaching therein, and may meet with the Board of Trustees, and submit to them such advice and recommendations as they may deem proper in regard to the management and needulness of said institute.—Extract from Charter of Garrett Biblical Institute.
