## PREFACE.



It is the design of this Question-Book to familiarize the minds of children with the grand facts of the Incarnation. If the plan of instruction is faithfully followed out, the scholar who begins the Lessons with Advent will have in his memory by Whit-Sunday a brief life of our Saviour in the very words of Scripture. The permanent value of such a possession as this will be admitted by every one who is himself conscious of an indistinct recollection of the order of the Gospel story. The selections of sacred poetry appended to the several Lessons have been gathered with some carefulness, and in each case have a bearing on the topic of the day.

Should these Questions meet with a favorable reception in the Church at large, a corresponding book, based on the narratives of the Old Testament, will be put forth for use during the season that intervenes between Trinity and Advent Sundays. It has been thought best to issue this first part separately, for the reason that, in many Sunday-schools,

a long summer vacation breaks up the continuity of the year. Such schools will, perhaps, be glad of a book that can be fairly finished before the vacation begins. While schools that have no vacation can readily take up another course of study when this one is concluded.
