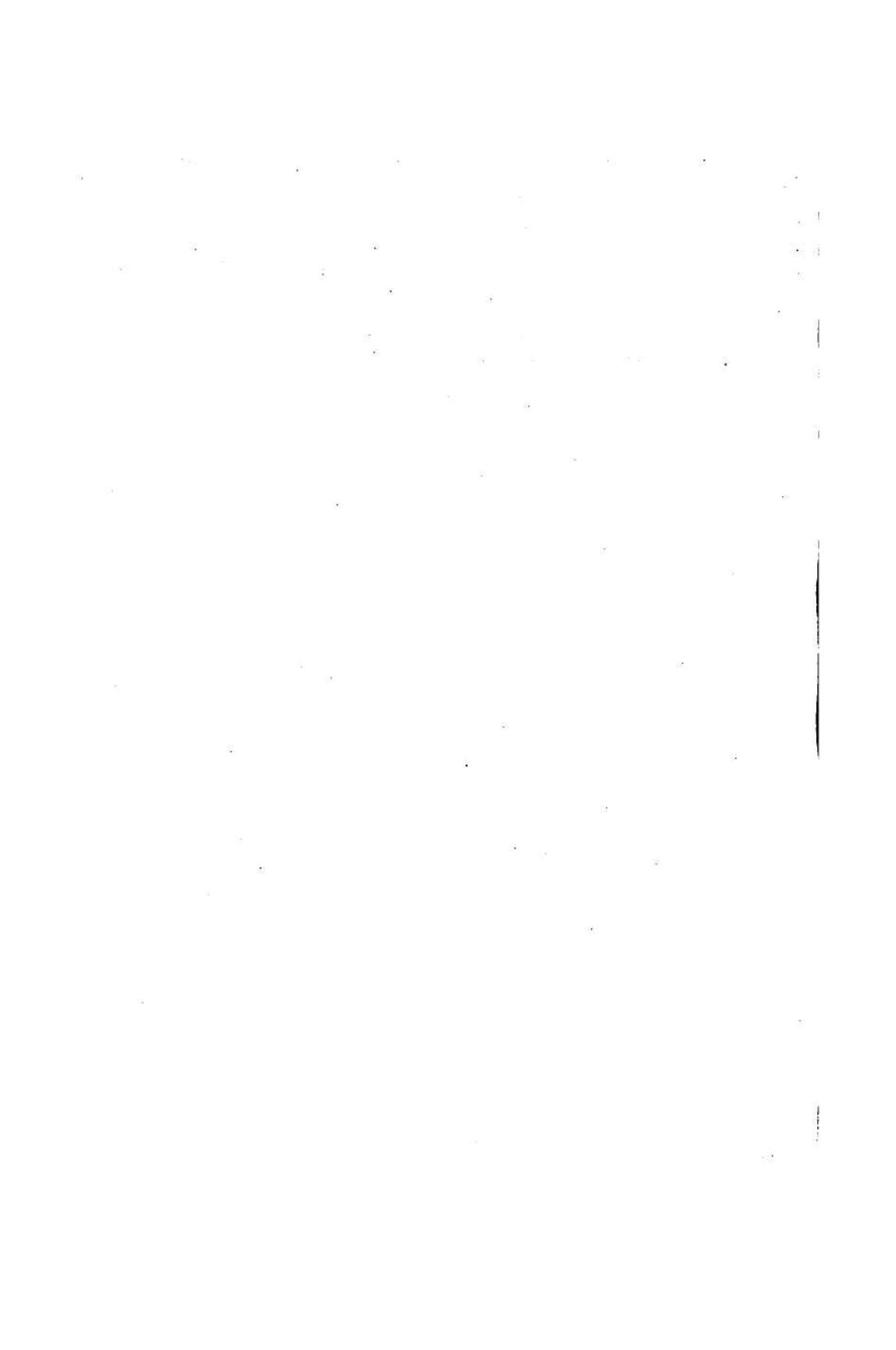

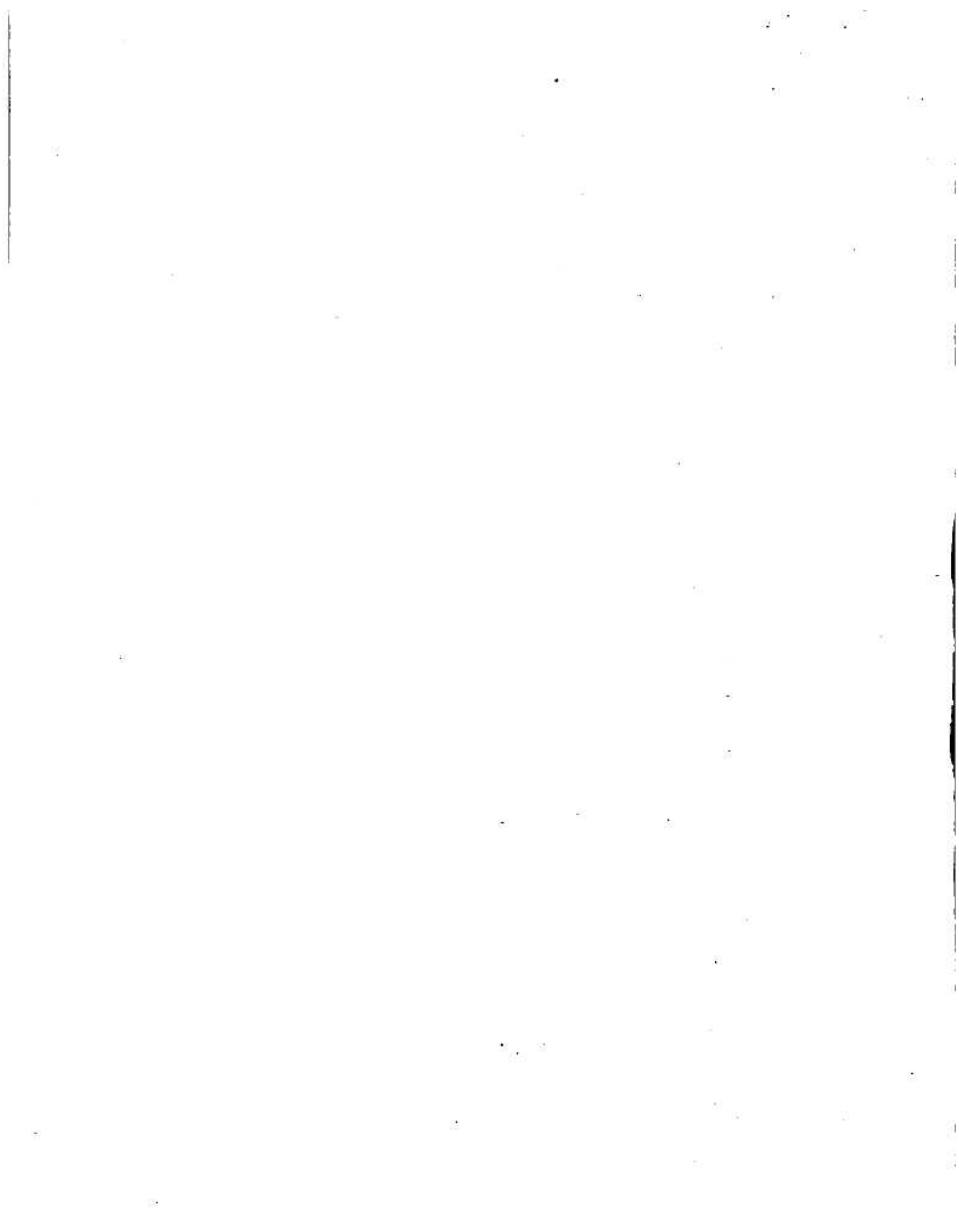


## PREFACE.

THE Topographical Index contained in the following pages was framed by me, for my own use, in connection with a work on the site of our Lord's Sepulchre, on which I have been engaged, at leisure moments, for some time past. Partly for my own convenience, and partly from a desire that whether that work should ever be completed or not, something of the labour which it has entailed should not be lost, I have thrown this Index into print. It is not a compilation which, even were it perfect, could ever attract the public; and it is essentially imperfect, and only what it is styled—"a contribution."
