Editorial.

SOME apology is needed for the comparatively small size of the present volume. This, however, is due to the fact that the extraordinary expenditure incurred in publishing our Transactions during the past two or three years, has left the finances of the Society in such a condition that the volume for this year has had to be produced at less than half the usual cost. In future years it is hoped the Transactions will attain their average size.

In order to make the present issue as interesting and valuable as the circumstances permit, the various manuscripts in the Society's possession have been carefully examined, and preference has been given to those most likely to be of general utility. For the same reason, portions of some of the papers which contained information accessible in the standard monographs or text books, have been omitted.

Since the last part of our Transactions was published, Lord Liverpool, who was our President for many years, has been removed from us. The present opportunity has, therefore, been taken of reproducing his portrait, and of making some record of the services he rendered to our Society. I have also taken the liberty of inserting some "Local Archæological Notes," records of important discoveries, and of papers, &c., likely to be of special interest to East Riding Antiquaries. Blocks in illustration of these have been kindly lent by the York Philosophical Society, and by the Hull Museum authorities. It is proposed to repeat these local notes year by year, in order that a record may be kept of matters of local interest.
