The following resolutions were adopted by the Institute, and ordered to be printed every year with the published proceedings :

Resolved : That the American Institute of Homœopathy does not necessarily endorse the doctrines contained in the reports of committees, by accepting and publishing such reports with the proceedings.

Resolved : That we regard the Homœopathic law as co-extensive with disease, and that a resort to any other medicinal means than those pointed out by the law, *similia similibus*, is the result, in part, of the incompleteness of our *Materia Medica*, but mainly the result of a want of sufficient knowledge on the part of the physician of those remedies already possessed by our school, and not an insufficiency of the Homœopathic law.
