PREFACE TO THE THIRD EDITION

THE converging influence of discoveries made during the nineteenth century in many diverse departments of knowledge has of late years notably increased the uncertainty which thoughtful persons have often felt about the best method of utilising Old Testament narratives for the education and edification of children. Nor has the difficulty been altogether confined to the oldest writings; it cannot be maintained that general conviction of the truth of the cardinal doctrines of the New Testament has remained quite unshaken.
