

PREFACE TO NEW EDITION

CRITICS may ask why a book published sixteen years ago is reprinted without addition as 'Aspects of Modern Oxford.' Many things, they will say, have happened since then : there is a new golf course, and no one now plays ringoal. And why does he not say something about Ruskin College or University Reform ? I have two defences, and the critic may take whichever he likes. 1 might say that assorted impressions drawn from periods so diverse as the nineteenth century (now recognised as mistaken) and the twentieth (generally acknowledged to be right) would be too miscellaneous to appear within the same covers. Or, again, I could plead that what was true in 1893 is still true in 1909, because Oxford only appears to alter, and in reality remains very much the same : 'plus cela change, plus c'est la même chose.'
