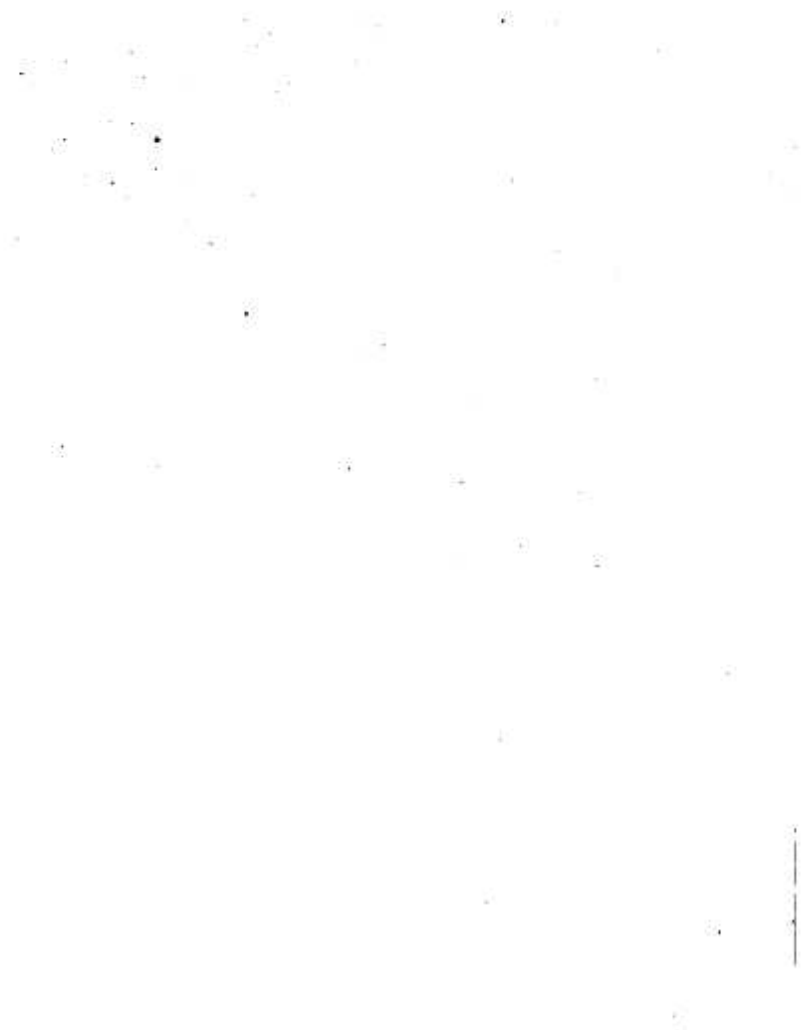

*WALKING WITH GOD.*

“ Enoch walked with God.”—*Gen. v. 24.*

“ By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death ; and was not found, because God had translated him : for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.”—*Heb. xi. 5.*
