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REPORT.

GENERAL TREASURER'S OFFICE,

PROVIDENCE, R. I., January, 1903.

To the Honorable the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations:

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 33, Title VI, of the General Laws, I have the honor to submit a statement of the transactions of the treasury department, showing the receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1903, an exhibit of the condition of the State House Construction Sinking Fund, Touro Jewish Synagogue Fund, the Land Grant Fund of 1862, and various other funds in custody of the State.

Reference to the treasurer's reports for the past few years shows a gradual decrease in the surplus at the close of business each year. While there has been a slight increase in current receipts, owing to the rapid growth in business and population in our State, there has been an increase in the expenses of the departments and institutions; and inasmuch as the current income is barely sufficient to meet the demands for current expenses, it is evident that new sources of revenue must be found or a deficit in the near future in the general fund is unavoidable.

A list of the present sources of revenue will be found in the appendix, with the amount derived from each; also a list of the unexpended balances of special appropriations made by the General Assembly of 1903, which must be paid from the current receipts of the ensuing year.
