PREFACE.

THE little village of Whitwell-on-the-Hill, comprising the small population of two hundred souls, is situate in the North Riding of the county of York, on the first sloping ground that rises out of the dead level of the plain of York, distant about twelve miles from that city on the Scarborough road. It is said to derive its name from the singular milk-like colour of the water of a well, now covered over, in front of the Hall.

Whitwell was formerly Church property,
