PREFACE



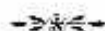

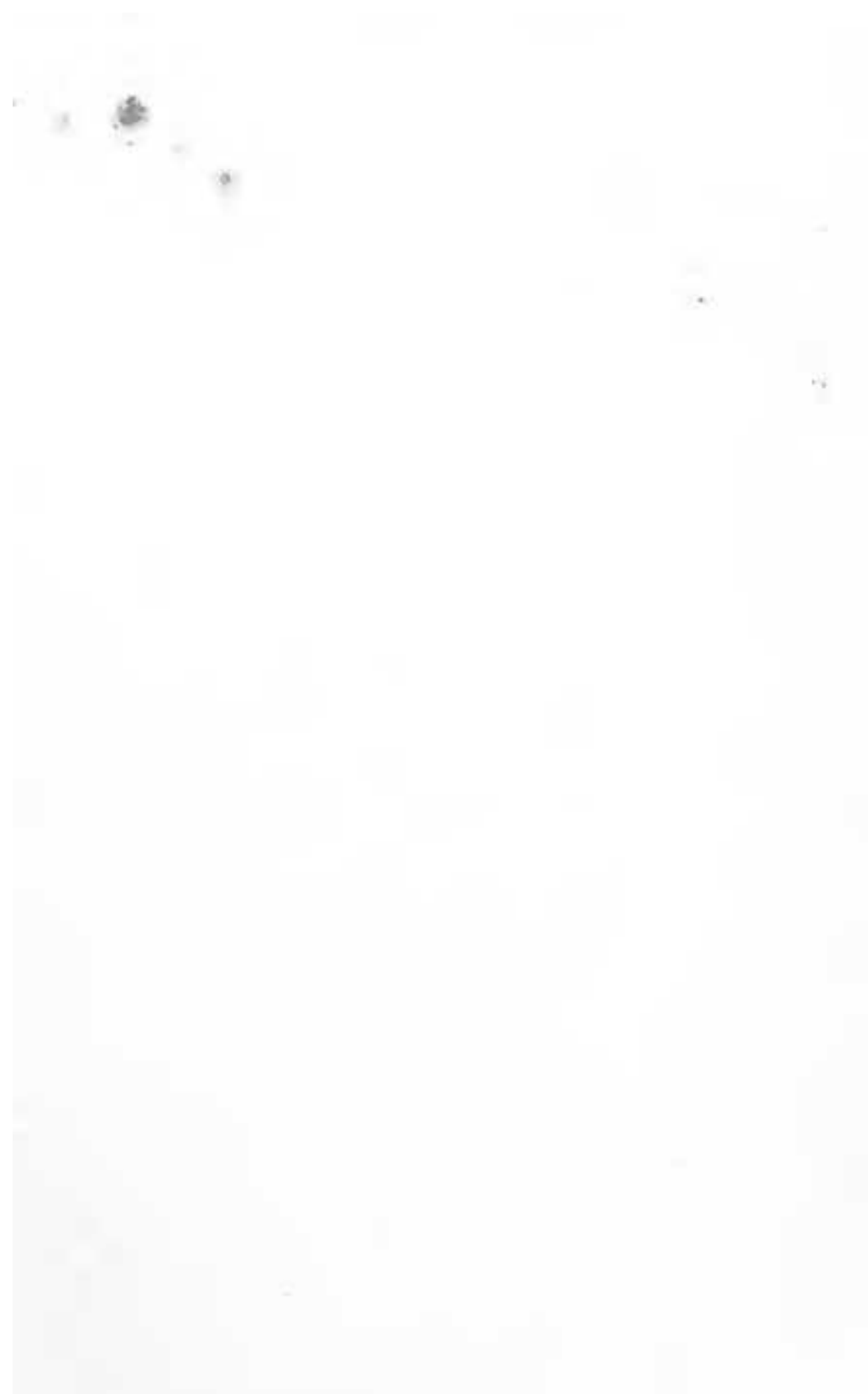
