REPORT OF SECRETARY OF STATE.

STATE OF ILLINOIS, DEPARTMENT OF STATE,

SPRINGFIELD, ILL., OCTOBER 1, 1890.

To His Excellency, JOSEPH W. FIFER, Governor:

In conformity with the law defining the duties of the Secretary of State, I have the honor to present herewith my first biennial report, as required by law, also a statement of all fees received by me and paid to the State Treasurer from January 15, 1889, the date on which I assumed the duties of my office, to October 1, 1890, the close of the fiscal year, together with such other matters as are required of me by law.

The fees received by this department for the period above stated and paid into the State treasury have been more than were ever received in the same length of time, amounting to \$35,746.27, as follows:

As the law requires that the Secretary of State shall make semi-annual reports to the Governor on the first days of April and October in each year, I herewith give a statement of my reports, as follows:

From January 15, 1889, to April 1, 1889, two and one-half months, I received fees as follows:

Total amount paid the State Treasurer, \$35,746.27.

I have also received the sum of six hundred and thirty dollars for rent on the dwelling house owned by the State, and have paid the same to the State Treasurer.

PRINTING.

The last General Assembly appropriated thirty thousand dollars to meet the expenses of two years' public printing, of which amount about \$.0,000 was paid for printing Agricultural and Fat Stock Show Reports of 1886 and 1887, Reports of the Board of Health of 1886, House and Senate Journals of 1887, and other work which should have been printed during the administration of my predecessor, but he was unable to have the work done for the reason that about fourteen thousand dollars of the amount appropriated by the Thirty-fifth General Assembly was in litigation between the Commissioners of State Contracts and the contractor for printing, which amount could not
