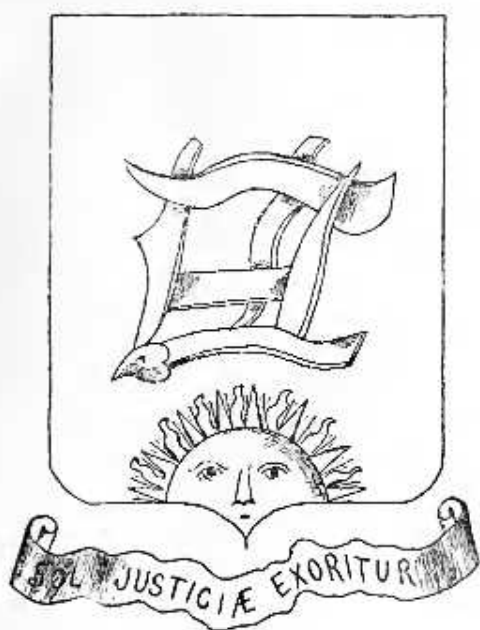

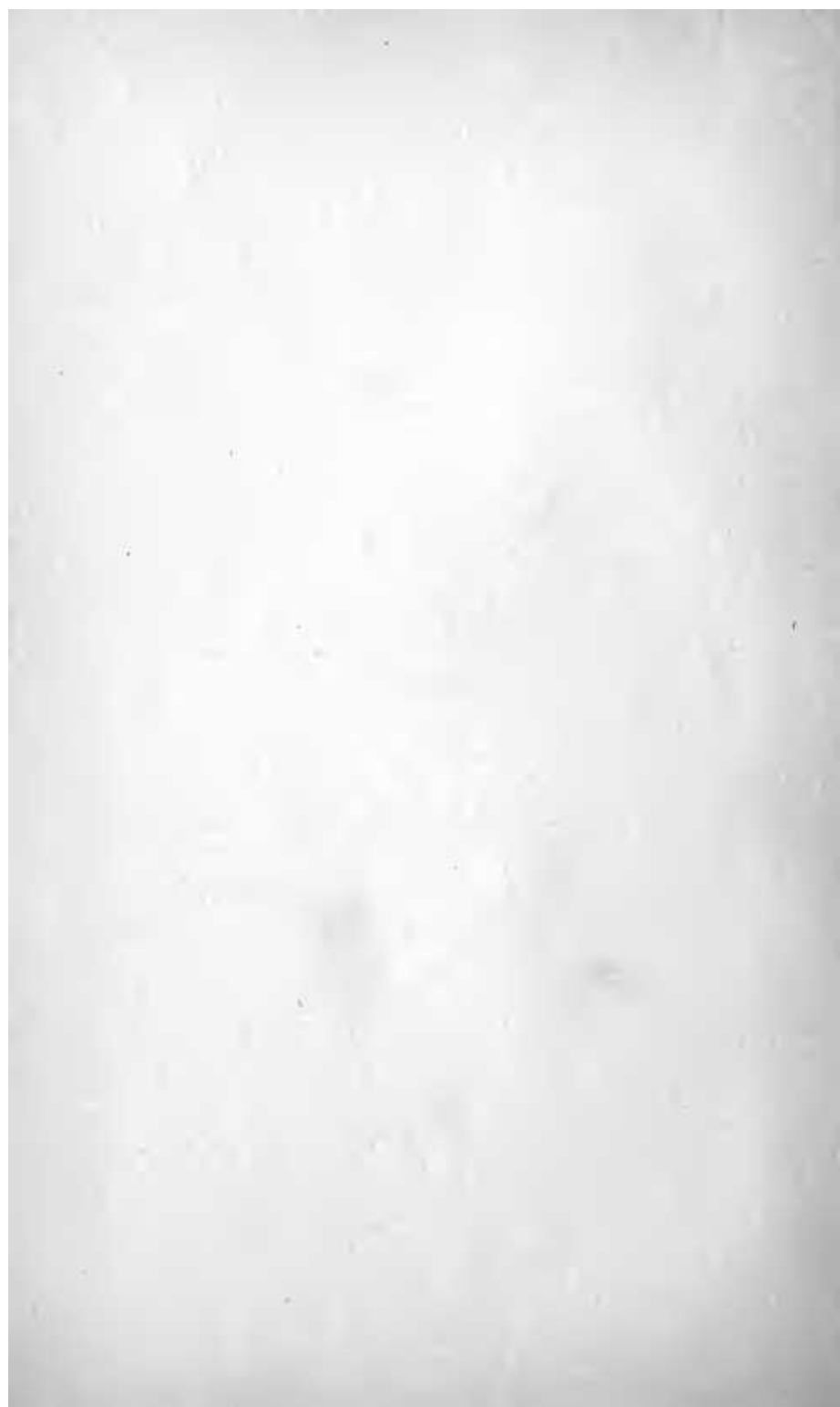

PREFACE.

IN August, 1899, a meeting of the descendants of REUBEN and MOSES BATCHELDER, of Hampton Falls, was held at Dearborn Hall, in Seabrook, and it was voted to organize and hold meetings annually.
