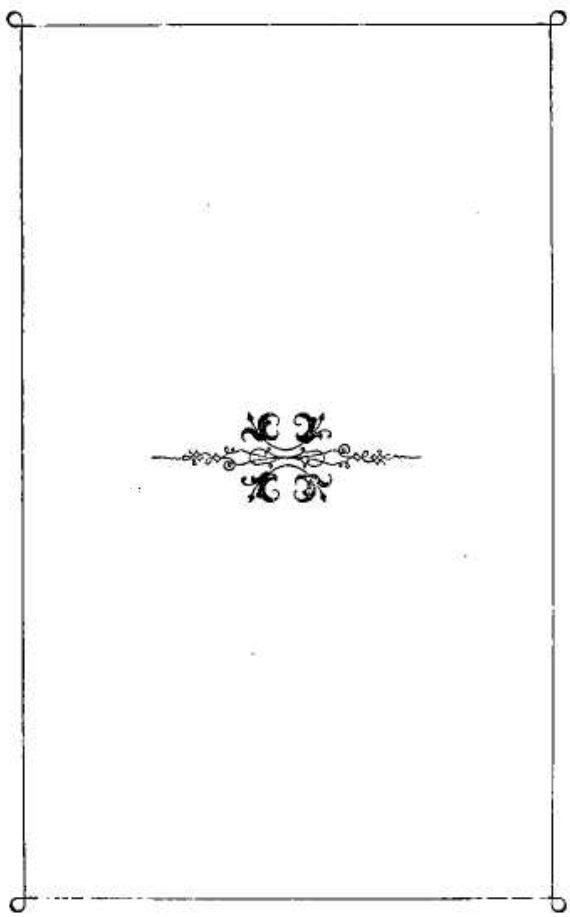

Prefatory Note.

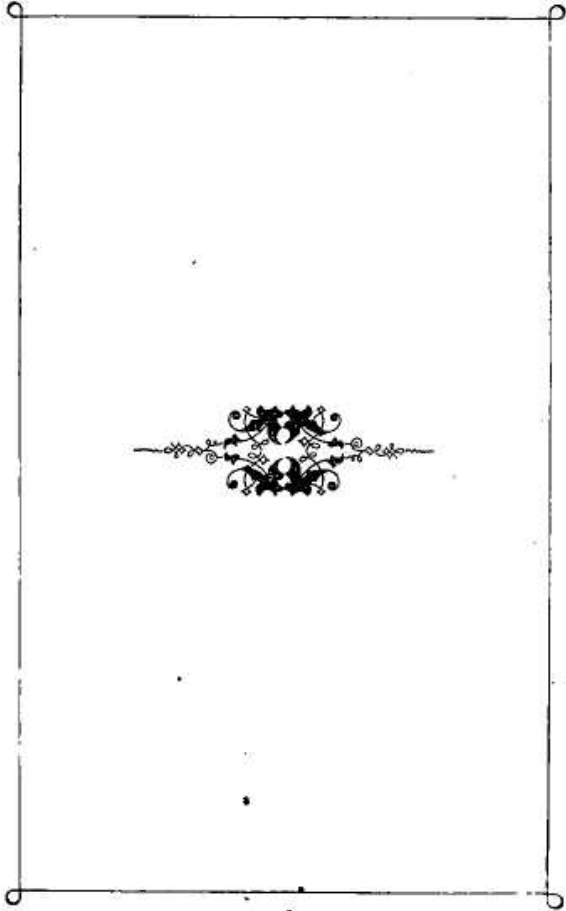
