PREFACE.

This Table is a Chronological Table of the Royal Orders in Council which have been promulgated in this Island between the 26th day of April, A.D. 1831, and the 30th day of June, A.D. 1877, and of the several Ordinances passed by the Governor and Council between the 25th day of April, A.D. 1831 and the 30th day of June, 1877.

The Table is framed with these objects,

- (1.) To show what Orders in Council and Ordinances are not in force and how the same have ceased to be in force whether by express repeal or otherwise:
- (2.) With respect to Orders in Council and Ordinances partly in force, to give any express partial repeals thereof. Many of the Orders in Council and Ordinances cannot be regarded as public, that is as affecting the community generally, being in their nature special or private, relating to particular persons, or places, or to private concerns. Such, therefore, have been distinguished by the italic entries *Local*, *Private* in the second column of the Table.

With respect to entries in the third Column of the Table the following has been the ordinary practice,

- 1° Those Orders in Council and Ordinances which have effected their object and have no present operation, such as Appropriation Ordinances and Ordinances repealing former Ordinances, have been entered as "Spent." The last mentioned Ordinances have been classed as "Spent" by operation of the Ordinance No. 18 of 1874 section 4:
- 2° Those whose effect is limited to a certain time which has past and which never having been continued are no longer law have been classed as "Expired:"
- 3° Those which have been expressly repealed are so entered; and in cases in which an Order in Council or Ordinance has been more than once repealed, the repealing Orders in Council or Ordinances have all been entered. As a general rule no notice has been taken of implied repeals:
- 4° Those of the Public Orders in Council and Ordinances now in force, but which from failure of the subject matter to which they relate or from other causes are practically inoperative, have been entered as "Obsolete."

The dates of the Proclamations notifying Confirmation of Ordinances have been entered in the fourth Column, only in cases where the Order in Council or Ordinance is either actually in force or partially so—in other cases the entry of such dates has been omitted.

This Chronological Table has been framed by Mr. GEORGE LEWIS GARCIA, under the supervision of the Attorney-General, the Honourable HENRY LUDLOW.

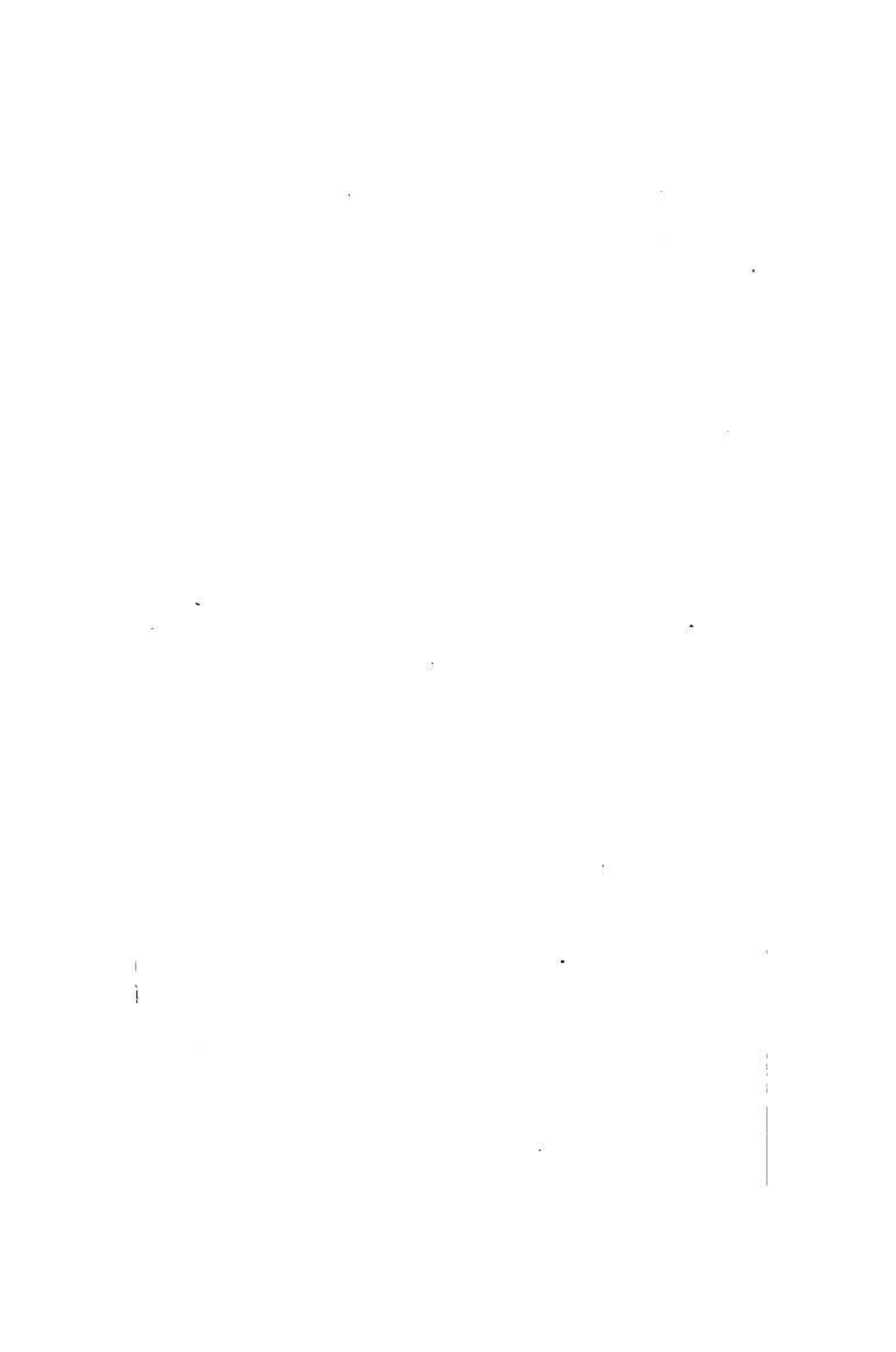
