## PREFACE

THESE graded word lists contain words arranged by grades and in classes. The graded lists are eight in number. Each grade has a required list and an optional list, excepting that in the eighth grade the optional list is omitted, since a general review is desirable in this grade. In addition, there is a supplementary list for such use as opportunity and need may suggest.

The lists have been made up by a committee of principals, with the assistance of class teachers, in the Town of Norwalk, Connecticut, and constitute a practical requirement within the limits of what elementary school pupils may reasonably be expected to accomplish. The required lists represent the minimum attainments. The optional lists, of words often as important as those in the required lists, represent a medium requirement.

Care has been taken to avoid useless and unusual words.

In spelling and syllabication, we have followed the International Dictionary.
