Cammaerts' only purpose has been to follow, as closely as possible, the swing of the French verse, with its constant changes of rhythm, in order to facilitate the task of those who might experience some difficulty in reading the original.

Thanks to the generosity of Miss A. Bryer, Lord Curzon of Kedleston, Mr. A. P. Graves and Mr. G. H. Bush, we have been able to include their excellent versions of four of the poems.

We must express our gratitude to the editor of the *Observer* for allowing us to reproduce here the *Patriotic Songs* which were first published in that paper, and to the editor of the *Spectator* for allowing us to reproduce the translation of *A Voice in the Desert*.
