- V. MEMBERSHIP. The Condition of Membership shall be Charity, and not belief; Discipleship, and not saintship.
- VI. CHILDREN Growing up to families of our churches, shall be treated as members thereof when confirmed.
- VII. CHURCH MEMBERSHIP. This is permanent; but no one shall be bound against his Conscience, nor corrupt the body by immorality.
