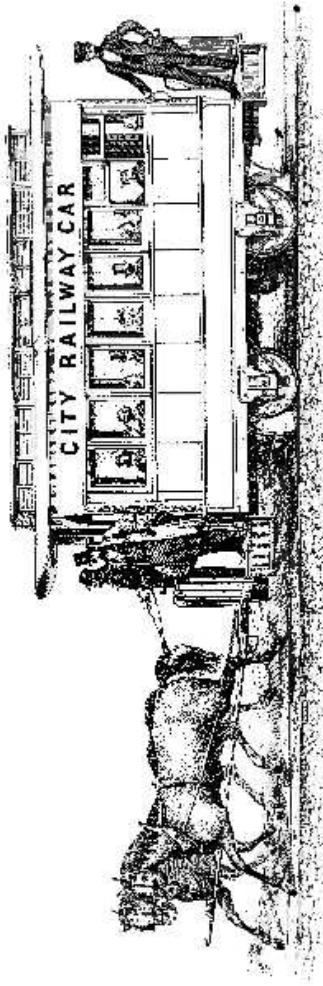
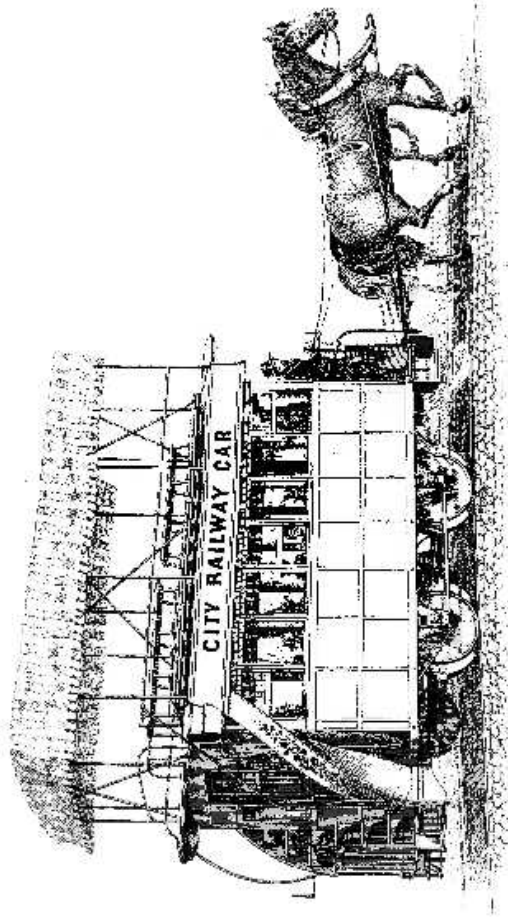


Fig. 1. Patent by W. Post, 211 Walnut St. Phil.
