REPORT OF THE COUNCIL

or

The Pipe Roll Society.

THE last Report presented to the Pipe Roll Society by the Council, is to be found in Vol. XII., which was issued in the year 1891.

Since that date two more volumes have been published, Vol. XIII., which contains the Pipe Roll for 15 Henry II., and Vol. XIV., which consists of the three earliest Rolls of the King's Court, all of which belong to the reign of Richard I.

This volume, which contains an Introduction and Notes contributed by Professor MAITLAND, occupied a much longer time in editing than the usual volumes, owing to the necessity of sending each sheet to Cambridge for Professor MAITLAND's perusal.

The present volume, No. XV., contains the Pipe Roll of 16 Henry II., and is issued to the Subscribers in return for their subscriptions for the year 1891-2.

The copy of the Pipe Roll for 17 Henry II. has already been sent to the printers, and will be issued to the Society as the equivalent for the subscription for the year 1892-3.

And we further report that the following is an Abstract of the Receipts and Expenditure during the period we have mentioned:—


