PREFACE

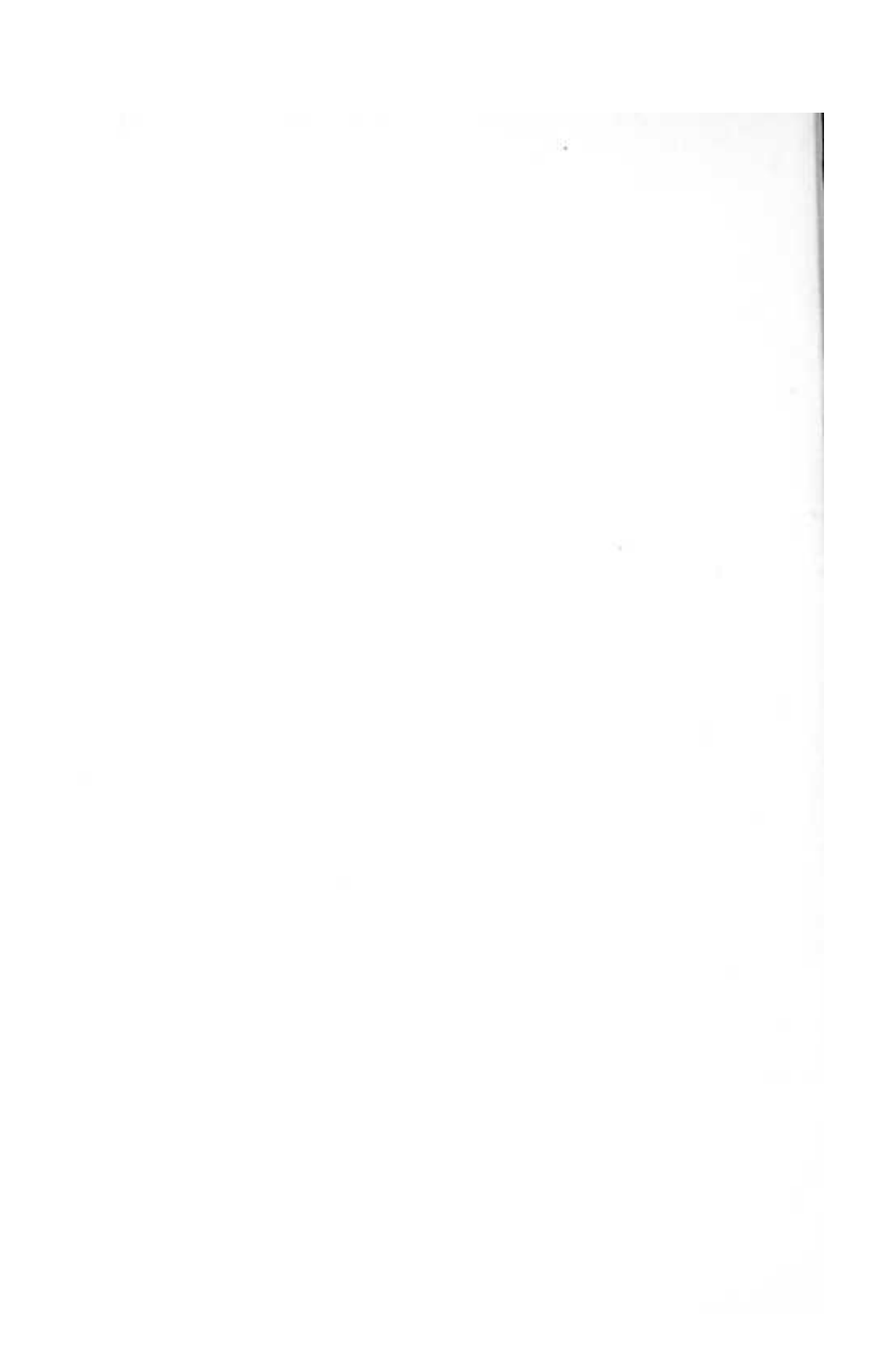
