

#### INTRODUCTORY.

So much has been written of late about the condition of the women of our Eastern Empire, that there does not seem much left for any new writer to say on the subject. Still, the country is of such vast extent, and peopled by so many different nations, that the restraints imposed upon the females differ greatly in the different parts of India; and even in these are modified by the rank and position in the social scale which the families occupy.

Over the greater part of the Bengal Presidency and the North-West Provinces, where the Mussulman element preponderates, a much greater degree of seclusion and isolation from all society, beyond
