THE "PERFECT" CORK HANDLE GREENHEART TROUT OR GRAYLING ROD.

They are made in 2 and 3 pieces, varying in lengths from 9 ft. to 11 ft., the length found to be most useful is 10 ft. 6 in. The grips of these Bods are made of solid Cork, thereby dispensing with the wood that is usually left for the grip; the cork handle has a hole bored through it to receive the butt, which is the same size under the cork as above the grip, consequently the play is continued to the winch, thereby giving greater easting power than ordinary Rods of the same length.

The great advantage of the cork grip is that these Rods are considerably lighter than the ordinary trout rods, as will be seen from the weights below; the weights were taken from Bods selected indiscriminately from stock.

They are made with straight metal ferrules, thereby reducing to a minimum the chances of throwing out when casting.


They can be made lighter if wished, but the weights given are for really




