### Adbent Sunday.

#### READY.

Verse to learn-

"Therefore, be ye also ready ; for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of Man cometh."—St. Matt. xxiv. 44.

Key-note ready. "Son of man"—Son of God too, Jesus Christ. Where is Jesus now? Disciples saw Him go away (Acts i. 9). And one day He will come again (verse 11). Sure to come, for He said so Himself (St. Matt. 1xiv. 30). Do not know when; but even if we are dead and asleep, we shall wake to see Jesus when He comes.
