## REGULATIONS.

ABTICLE 1: The Firemen's Lyceum shall be open from 9 A. M. to 4 P. M. daily, Sundays excepted.

ART. 2. All members of the Department may avail themselves of the privileges of the Library, subject to such rules and regulations as may be from time to time adopted.

ART. 3. No person shall take a book from the Library without first having the same charged to him in the books

of the Library.

ABT. 4. Books will be delivered to members applying personally, or by written order only; and no books so drawn by a privileged party shall be loaned.

ART. 5. Each member shall be entitled to but one book

at a time.

ART. 6. Every member may detain each book, delivered as aforesaid, two weeks, or for any less time; and if kept longer than the time limited shall forfeit for every day a volume is so detained two cents; and the fine exacted shall be deducted from mouthly pay.

ART. 7. The cleanliness of the books will add to the interest of the Library, and members using them will avoid

soiling them.

ART. 8. If any member lose, soil, deface by marking, or otherwise mutilate a book, he shall make the same good; and if the book lost or injured be one of a set, he shall be charged the full value of said set, and may thereupon receive the remaining volumes as his property.

ART. 9. Members of the Department may have access to the Library, when not on duty, for the purpose of reading or examining books; the use of tobacco in any form

being prohibited.

ART. 10. The accounts with the Library of any member withdrawing from the Department must be examined before his final payment, and a certificate given by the Librarian that no books are charged to him and not returned.
