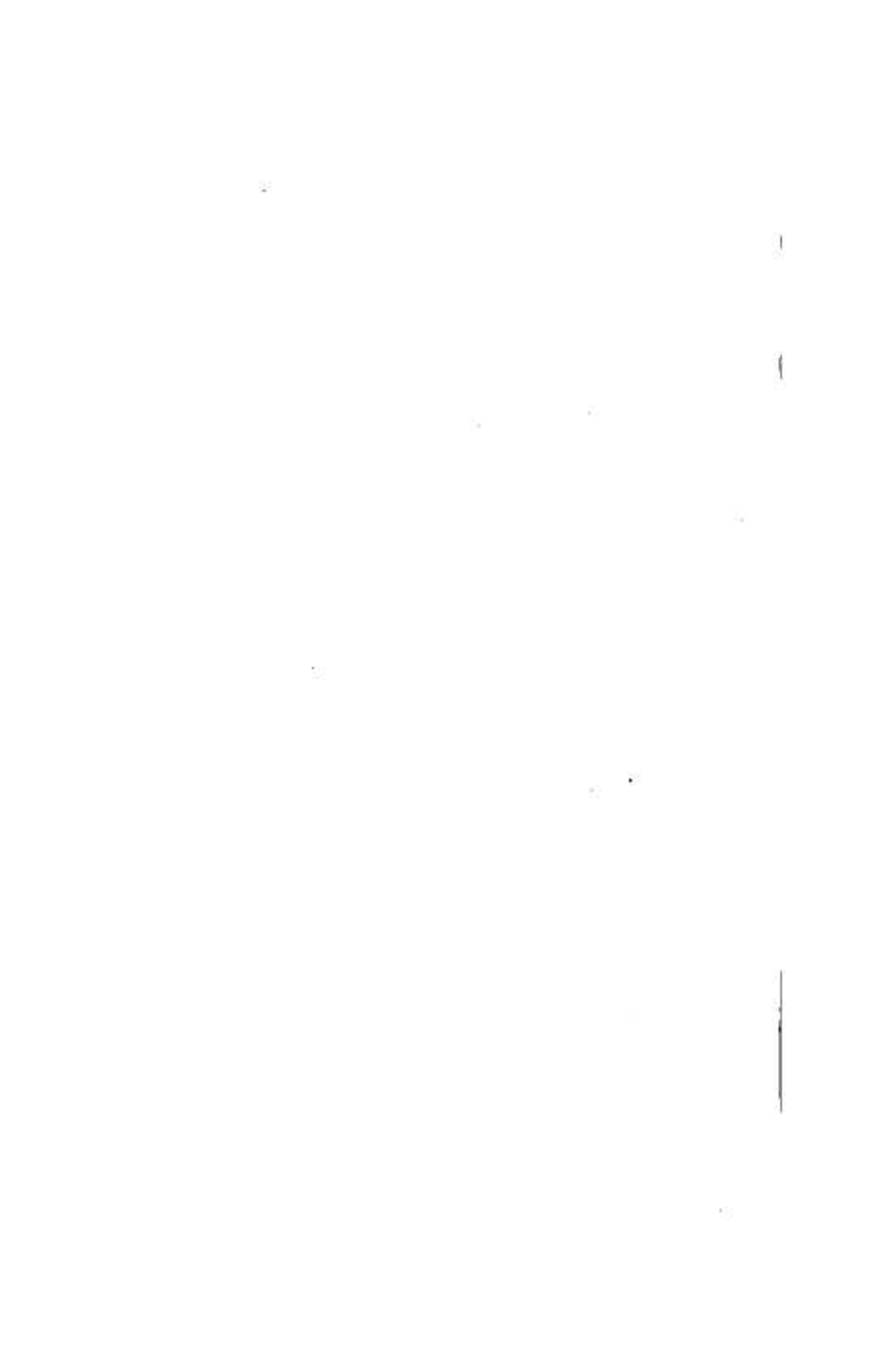
## Preface.
