





The Ladies' Sewing Circle also meets once a month, in the Librau Room, and all ladies of the Congregation are invited to attend.




#### [Extracts from Ecclesiastical Rules.]

It is expected that members of other churches, who may wish to commune with this church for more than one year, will request a removal of their connection to us.

Members who remove to other places, or worship or commune with other churches, are required to procure letters of dismission and recommendation from this church, within one year from the time of leaving us, unless for further delay they shall satisfy the Examining Committee.

It is the duty of the members to attend such stated meetings as are appointed by the church, unless providentially prevented.

Any member wishing to withdraw from this to another church should signify his wishes and his reasons, and apply in a proper spirit to be first released from his obligations to this church. Any other mode of withdrawing will be deemed irregular and censurable.
