J. Noble Coleman, M.A., for the collocation of the speeches in the last two chapters. For the imperfections in my conception of the meaning of difficult passages, which occur in the Authorized Version of Job, Ecclesiastes, and Revelation, I must throw myself on the indulgence of the reader. As for the Drama of Solomon and his Bride, it professes merely to be founded on the Song of Songs; I therefore hope that it will not be judged in comparison therewith.
