PREFACE.

THE exigencies of the Public call for an entirely new edition of the Acts which regulate extramural interments. This work has therefore been prepared with the view of furnishing Burial Boards and their officers with a practical guide in the right execution of their duties; Boards of Guardians with an exposition of the law relating to the burial of poor persons at the cost of the poor rates in new burial grounds provided under the Burial Board Acts; and the Public with lucid information as to the nature of the new law in regard to burial grounds and burials. The Introduction treats of the law with respect to Burials generally, and particularly of the new Burial These Acts are then given in extenso, with practical notes and references; together with

the whole of the decisions of the courts upon those Acts up to the present time. The Appendix contains the regulations and instructions issued by the Secretary of State for the Home Department under the 15 & 16 Vict. c. 85, 16 & 17 Vict. c. 134, 17 & 18 Vict. c. 87, and 18 & 19 Vict. c. 128. The Index is voluminous.
