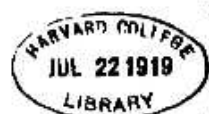

THE following notes are supplemental to those contained in two papers on the Muniments of the College which are printed in the Fourth and Eighth Reports of the Royal Commission on Historical MSS., issued in the years 1874 and 1881. They consist of memoranda made by the Editor for his own use, while engaged at intervals during fourteen years upon a catalogue of the whole collection. But as the total number of documents (ranging in date between the twelfth and the seventeenth centuries) amounts to nearly fourteen thousand, it will be readily understood that these notes, even when taken in conjunction with the papers above mentioned, afford but specimens of the varied contents of such accumulated stores. How from one dissolved Priory or Hospital and another, and from one family and another, the charters and papers came to the College, is told in the Reports; here it is sufficient to say that with reference to more than half the counties in England copious materials for local history are to be found in them, while the history and descent of many a family (*e.g.* of those of Braose, De Quincy, Peche, Rich, Poer, St. Liz, Freyne, Multon, D'Amory, with numerous others) are largely illustrated.

The College publishes these notes (placed at their service by the Editor) in the belief that many outside the Society will be interested in their contents.
