N O T I C E.

THE Minister of Christ's Church, Longwood, — or, in his absence, the most suitable person among the teachers of the Sunday School, — shall open the School with the following Sentences of Scripture, and then read the Selected Service for the children.

After the service is closed, the Minister or Teacher is to read to the children the Address on the "Elements of Christianity;" and, when that is finished, he is to notify the several teachers present to assemble the children in their separate classes, and instruct them in such manner as their respective parents may sanction and direct.

N.B.—The Sunday-school Service takes the place of the Afternoon Service in the Gospel Churches. It may be shortened on the discretion of the Minister or Teacher; but the Prayer to Almighty God, the Ten Commandments, and the Words of our Saviour, must be read previous to the Address to the Children.

¶ The Minister shall begin the selected service by reading the following sentences of Scripture:

THE LORD is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him. —
Hab. ii. 20.

From the rising of the sun even unto the going down of the same, my name shall be great among the Gentiles; and in every place incense shall be offered unto my name, and a pure offering: for my name shall be great among the heathen, saith the Lord of hosts. — *Mal.* i. 11.

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be always acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my Strength and my Redeemer. — *Ps. xix. 14.*

† Then the Minister shall say,

DEARLY beloved, the Scripture moveth us, in sundry places, to acknowledge and confess our manifold sins and wickedness, and that we should not dissemble nor cloak them before the face of our heavenly Father, but confess them with an humble, lowly, penitent, and obedient heart, to the end that we may obtain forgiveness of the same, by his infinite goodness and mercy. And although we ought, at all times, humbly to acknowledge our sins before God, yet ought we chiefly so to do when we assemble and meet together to render thanks for the great benefits that we have received at his hands, to set forth his most
