## THE JOYS OF CHRISTMAS

"Through the tender mercy of our God, whereby the Dayspring from on high hath visited us, to give light to them that sit in darkness and the shadow of death, and to guide our feet into the way of peace."

I will speak to you this morning of the joy of Christmas. The peculiarity of Christmas joy is that it belongs to the present life, to the present hour, to earthly homes, human love, and is therefore universal. Christmas stands for the blessings which all men inherit by being born under the influences of Christianity.-the birthright blessings of all of us. Easter is also a feast of joy, but it is for those who have faith in immortality. It is a festival of hope, looking forward to a higher world.
