## PREFACE

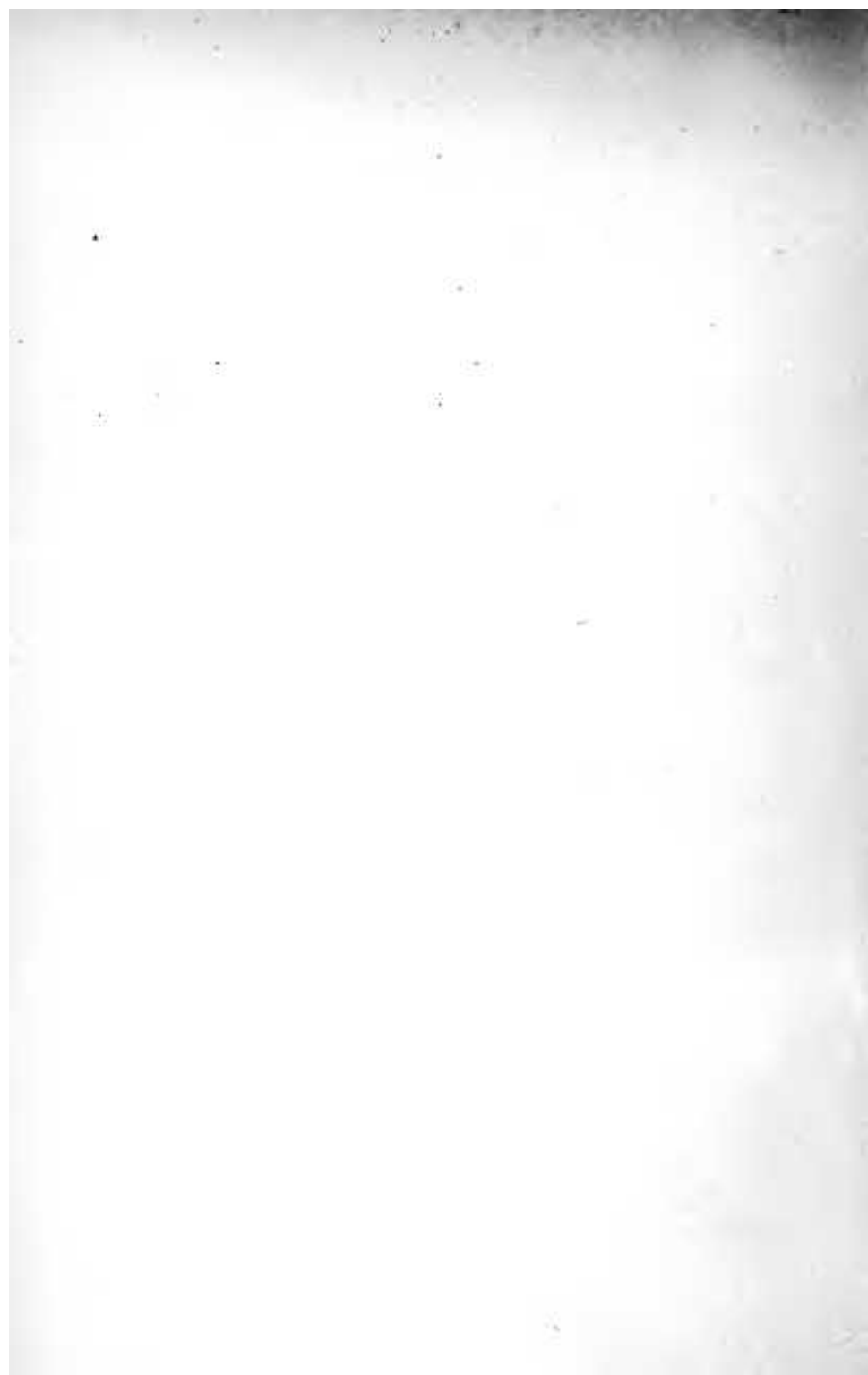
