PREFACE.

The object of the following book, is to give a concise and connected view of the life and labors of the Redeemer of mankind, in such a manner as to interest the young, lead them to desire more and fuller knowledge of him, and accustom them to see that all the circumstances of his history address themselves to our human sympathies, and should call forth our free but reverential thought.


expect that his judgment in omitting and retaining, will be in every instance confirmed by those who read: he must be contented with having carefully considered what he has done.
