Prefatory Aote

N this, the third volume of the "Bibliotheca Celtica," some alteration of the arrangement adopted in the previous volumes has been made. The attempt to combine an author and a "classed" catalogue, according as the kind of matter to be indexed seemed to call for varying treatment, has been found inconvenient, and has therefore given place to an arrangement in accordance with the acknowledged rules of "Author" cataloguing.

The body of the work is arranged in one alphabet by author, or where the author is unknown by title. In all cases where the author is known, although not given in the book, the work is indexed under the author's name. Compound names are indexed under the last name, for instance William Rhys-Herbert appears as Herbert, William Rhys-. So many cases have been encountered where the same author's name appears on one title-page with a hyphen, and on another without it, that this seems to be the only safe course to adopt.


The publications of Institutions and Societies appear under the town to which they belong, or, if a county or district organisation, under the county or district. For instance, the monthly meeting of the Vale of Clwyd Calvinistic Methodists appears under "Vale of Clwyd"; the Quarterly Association of the South Wales C.M. appears under "Wales — South Wales"; the Merionethshire Agricultural Society under "Merionethshire." National institutions appear directly under their names, e.g., the Congregational Union of Wales under "Congregationalists," the Welsh Bibliographical Society under "Welsh."

For indexing convenience all names of places and institutions are given in their English forms except where the Welsh or Gaelic form is invariably used.
