## FOREWORD

---

In compiling this second edition of the Smith College Song Book, the attempt has been made to keep it a book of "distinctively Smith College songs." On the other hand the effort to make the book essentially practical for present needs has meant the exclusion of some of the old songs which have not lasted with the years. The new songs, numbering some twenty-five, include serenades, basket ball songs, senior step, and Alma Mater songs which have become popular since the publication of the first edition and which show a marked tendency to remain favorites. The difficulty in securing permission to use songs already copyrighted has made it necessary to print only the words of several which would otherwise have appeared in this volume.

The committee extends hearty thanks to Mr. Sleeper, the head of the Music Department, for his generous assistance; to the song leaders and other alumnae who have given helpful suggestions, and to the various composers and publishing houses that have given permission to use their copyrights.

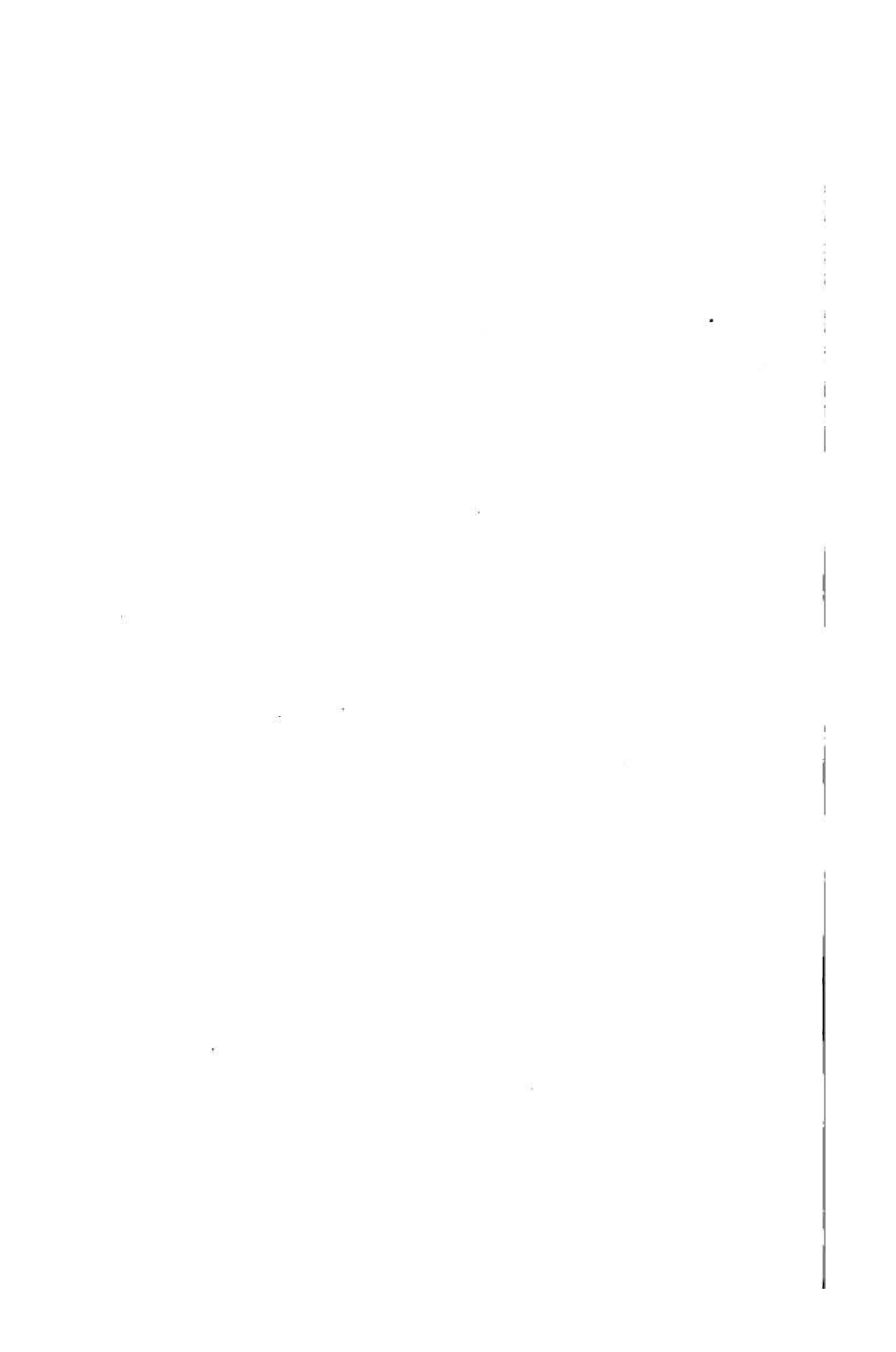
