#### PREFACE.

THIS Second German Reader presents in the form of reading-matter the subjects of conversation, prescribed by the Course of Study in the Public Schools of New York. It deals with the Objects in the Schoolroom, House and Family, Human Body, Domestic Animals, Clothing and Food.

It also adds some set conversations, to show the language without the restraint of grammar.

Then follow easy stories, poetry and descriptions, selected with the intention of sustaining the interest of the pupils and, at the same time, of providing material for practice in reading.


**Grammar** is added in a special Appendix, the use of which is optional with the teacher. The object of its arrangement is to create a grammatical feeling
