

Aconite.

Averse to noises: (Bell. Lyc Mur. ac) particularly music (Ambra Phos. ac). Intolerable roaring in ears: humming, ringing (China. Bell. Lyc). Pains in right ear (Ac. Aur. Bell. Colch. Hep. Lyc. Graph.) Stinging in ear, meatus red and narrow. External ear hot, red, and swollen (Bell. Apis). Pain, aggravated by draught of cold air. Neuralgia of ear and surrounding parts. Inflammation of ears, external and internal, with fever, and excruciating pains. Tearing pains in ears with a tickling sensation as of a worm alive in the ear.

General Indications: The leading expression of Aconite is a feverish, nervous restlessness, fear of death. Bad effects from dry, cold air, from suppressed perspiration, from excitement, from anxiety, fright, anger, chagrin. Sensitive to light and noise; fullness and heaviness of head and brain; face bloated, red, and hot. Especially applicable to plethoric persons or
