## PREFACE

**A**MONG the many and wonderful creations of the Catholic Church, the Order of Friars Preachers has a character peculiar to itself. The Orders of S. Benedict and of S. Francis have thrown out many various off-shoots from the old stem: the Order of S. Dominic has continued always compact and self-contained. For six hundred years it has retained its unity. This fidelity to its original type is not, however, from a lifeless sterility, but from the singular precision in its discipline and its traditions. It has been eminent both in the Schools and in the Missions of the Church. It has a multitude of saints, of doctors and of martyrs. In one only century, we are told in this book, that is from 1234 to 1334, 13,370 of its members received the crown of martyrdom.
